UPCOMING EVENTS

YOUTH TOURNAMENT- Saturday, November 7th will be our first ever state-wide SCTP youth tournament. The tournament will consist of 50 single, 50 wobbles and 25 pair doubles. There will also be a coach's challenge from 27 yards. So far, youth shooters will be coming from Anchorage, Sitka and Ketchikan. We will need volunteers to help out with this. MULTIPLEX SHOOT, SUNDAY, 11-8-15 – The Multiplex shoot date has been changed to Sunday November 8th due to the youth tournament. This is a registered shoot where 50 shots are fired in each event, singles, handicap and doubles. It's also a registered shoot against other trap clubs in the association and you gamble on your abilities to win or place in a Lewis Class outline.

Registration, trap and equipment set-up and set-out will be 8:30am to 9:25am Sunday. For new registered shooters a briefing and safety meeting will be held at 9:25am. First squad will be to the trap and their posts at 9:30am. The early forecast is mostly cloudy and a high of 42°F. Come on out and have some fun.

REGISTERED P.I.T.A. TRAP SHOOT-NOVEMBER 14TH, 2015; Our clubs regularly registered second Saturday of the month trap event will be on the 14th. This will be a P.I.T.A. registered event with A.T.A. cross registration permitted. This will be a 300 bird event consisting of 100 Singles (shot first), 100 Handicap and 50 pair of Doubles. Sign-up and trap field setup is from 8:30 to 9:25am. At 9:25am there will be a safety and procedures meeting for first time shooters. The first squad will be called to their posts at 9:30am.

The events fees are \$25 for the first 100 targets and \$15 for each additional 100 targets. There is a \$6.00 cross over fee to P.I.T.A. if you elect to cross register your targets. See you there.

Due to a possible shortage of targets, the P.I.T.A registered shoot may be postponed until the Turkey Shoot. An announcement will be sent out in the near future concerning postponement.

TURKEY SHOOT- Our annual Turkey Shoot will be Saturday, November 21st from 10:00am to 3:00pm.
