## **IDAHO PITA NEWSLETTER**

### **ISSUE #21. JUNE, 2016.**

June saw some spectacular shooting at the state shoot in Pocatello, the first summer Multiplex results, and two day shoots later in the month at both Pocatello and Twin Falls. Here are the results of these shoots.

#### **Idaho PITA State Shoot. Pocatello Trap Club. June 3 – 5, 2016.**

The five major championships were all won by shooters winning their first major Idaho PITA state championships. Roy Williams broke the only in-state 200 in the singles (using 20 gauge insert tubes) and also took the doubles championship when he fired his first 50 straight and then another for his first 100 in doubles.

Mike Lacey captured the High-All-Around championship with his score of 388 while Shawn Cahoon set a new state record of 780 to win the High-Over-All crown. This topped the previous record of 779 set by Ted Schlecht in 2006.

Lahoma Turner became only the second woman in the 85 year history of the state shoot to win the handicap championship with her near perfect 99. She also won her fifth ladies singles crown (and fourth in a row) and was the ladies doubles champion.

Shooters earning their Idaho PITA straight pins included: Ryan Hillyard – 25 and 50. Trish Yocum – 25. Ryan Loy – 25, 50, and 75. Dominic Wilson – 25. Mike Lacey – 25,

50, and 75. Renae Poseley James – 25. Roy Williams – 100 and 200. Dave Lisk – 25, 50, 75, and 100. Evan Ames – 25.

The weather was very nice all three days. There was a pizza party on Friday and steak dinner and special event on Saturday evening. 95 shooters from Idaho, Alaska, California, Washington, Nevada, Montana, Utah, and Oregon fired at 56,300 registered targets.

There was a short Honors and Business meeting held between events on Sunday where several shooters were recognized for their accomplishments.

Mike Rinard was introduced as the newest inductee into the Idaho Trapshooting Hall of Fame. Jim Kuntz was honored for winning the double 27 buckle for 2015. Spud Storey and Jim Fultz were recognized for earning spots on the parent PITA All-Star team. Storey, Fultz, Richard Wehren, Liz Harris, and Sam Nelson were presented their PITA Idaho High-Over-All team pins from the PITA.

The 2015 Idaho All-Star team members were then introduced. They were: Richard Wehren – Elder. Jim Fultz – Senior Vet. Chester Carter – Veteran. Jack Nelson – Junior team captain. Sam Nelson – Junior team. Ethan Smith – Junior team. June Gempler – Ladies team. Janet Merrill – Ladies team. Tina Wright – Ladies team. Connie Lancaster – Ladies team. Liz Harris – Ladies team captain. Open team members were: David Poseley, Lloyd Herbst, Jeff Wright, Jeff Scott, Norm Foster, Spud Storey, and Kent Harris.

It was the first All-Star team placement for Jack and Sam Nelson, Smith, Lancaster, and Herbst.

The meeting ended with Harris being presented with a milestone achievement award for shooting 300,000 PITA targets. He in turn presented the beautiful leather bag (with her name engraved on it) to his shooting partner, supporter, and wife of 30 years – Liz Harris.

In 2017 the state shoot is scheduled to be held at the Boise Gun Club in June.
