We kicked off the 2015 PITA shooting year with the Young Family Memorial Shoot and Multiplex shoots for November and December.

The Multiplex shoots continue to set records. The November Multiplex set records for clubs participating (38) and targets thrown (51,320). Also for only the second time in Multiplex history an Idaho shooter was the High-Over-All champion. Wayne McCulley (the Culdesac Kid) fired an outstanding 147 X 150 to lead a field of 381 shooters. Also Ray Ogle of Pocatello had one of the 49's that topped the handicap event. Shooters at Idaho clubs hit 29 Lewis payoffs.

Shooters dodged a day of record rain the day before the shoot and the skies cleared on Sunday but it was cold and windy (until the last shoot-off was done) and attendance and scores suffered. 41 shooters registered 9,200 targets and there were a number of youth shooters from Twin Falls, Ontario, and Boise taking part.

Twin Falls shooters walked off with most of the top honors as sub-junior Jared March topped the singles with 98, picked up a yardage win in the handicap, the junior trophy in the doubles, and bested his Dad Mike and Gene Hunt by two birds to win the Super High-Over-All shoot- off buckle. Richard Wehren was high in the doubles event with a lone 90. Tara Ortman won over John Booth in a two round shoot-off to take the handicap champions's buckle with a field high 87. Mike Carberry won the special 50 bird Rookie event with a 43. After a 60 bird shoot-off, Booth and Jeff Scott were declared Co – High-Over-All Champions with 263.
