Shooter's Responsibility

Display **ALL** your average cards at the Handicap Table immediately upon arrival. Shooters are required to have both their 16 yard and doubles averages computed for use by the Handicap Committee

PENALTY: At this shoot, class and yardage penalty will apply to shooters who do not have 500 16-yard and handicap targets in the current and previous year. Class B and 23 yards will be assigned. 300 targets are required in doubles in the current and previous year, or shoot Class B. Be sure your classification and handicap yardage are marked plainly on your entry form before you leave the table. It is your responsibility to know the rules. You are subject to penalties for shooting the wrong classification or on the wrong yardage even if your card is so marked. Targets shot in PITA registered competition may be counted to avoid penalty classification. It shall be the shooter's responsibility to inform the Handicap Committee as to their eligibility for special classification (Lady-1, Lady-II, Sub-Veteran, Veteran, Senior Veteran, Junior Gold, Junior and Sub-Junior) to be indicated on their entry form. Without such a declaration at the time of entry, the shooter will not be allowed to compete for the applicable special category trophies. NO EXCEPTIONS to this rule will be allowed.

If possible, please enter all events you plan to shoot at the time of your initial entry. This will save a considerable amount of time and make things more pleasant for all shooters.

No counter checks or second party checks will be accepted by the Cashier. Checks will be accepted for the amount of shooting fees only, no exceptions. All entries must be made in US funds.

RULES: By entering the competition, every contestant agrees to accept all official decisions and to abide by the ATA rules. Members are strongly encouraged to know the ATA rules and abide by them, both for their own benefit and for the benefit of other shooters.

Class winners and ties will be advanced one class for the next like event.

THREE MINUTE WAIT: Be ready to shoot when your squad is called. No shooter will be called on the speaker. Your squad will be allowed a wait of three minutes for you to take your place.

PLEASE CHECK YOUR SCORE AFTER FIRING AT EACH 5 TARGETS: According to ATA rules, the score keeper must keep the score sheet in plain view of the shooters at all times. If shooters insist on this, many arguments may be avoided. The squad leader (No. 1 shooter) will total the score after each 25 targets and initial the score sheet before leaving the trap. Errors made in totaling will be corrected when discovered. Any target other than clearly marked dead, shall be lost.

SHORT SQUADS: Short squads will be avoided when possible.

RELOADS: Reloads will be permitted at this tournament.

SAFETY: All persons including competitors, referees and trap personnel must wear eye and hearing protection while on the trap field. Failure to comply may result in disqualification.

GUN BREAKDOWN: In case of gun breakdown, a shooter will be allowed fifteen (15) minutes for gun repair or replacement.

TARGET SETTING: Targets will be set each morning and between events by the target setting committee according to ATA rules. Re-setting of targets will only be done by OSATA officials or designated line judges.

SHOOT-OFFS: Shoot-offs will be held following the last event of the day in the order they were shot. The first call will be announced 15 minutes after the last squad, in the last daily event, has finished shooting. The second call will be 5 minutes later. Any shooter who does not report to their assigned trap within three minutes after the second call will be disqualified. Ties will be shot off in all events unless all shooters involved in the tie agree to carry-over or other resolution of the tie.

IRS REGULATIONS: IRS regulations require a Social Security number for payout values of \$ 600.00 or greater.

PAYOUTS: The shooter must check the payout sheets before the start of the last event. Problems must be resolved prior to the end of the shoot or the results will stand as posted. Payouts will be made by check only and mailed within 10 days of the end of the shoot.

REFUNDS: No entry fee, purses, or options will be refunded after an event has started.

TROPHIES

- # 1 Should you win or tie for class in any singles or doubles event, or earn yardage in any handicap event, it shall be your duty to report to the Handicap Table and have your classification reviewed or yardage punched. Any shooter whose class or yardage is changed for any reason shall be considered to be notified when the new class or yardage is posted on the bulletin board.
- # 2 Any shooter failing to carry out rule # 1, or who shoots in a class or on a yardage marked higher or lower than that which is marked on his card, will be subject to penalty and will not be eligible to share in any money division or trophy whatsoever.
- # 3 Only one (1) ATA trophy shall be awarded to any one (1) person in any separate event.
- # 4 At all tournaments where All American points will be awarded, shooters may declare only one (1) Category (i.e. Lady 1, Lady II, Sub-Junior, Junior, Junior Gold, Sub-Veteran, Veteran or Senior Veteran).
- # 5 Any shooter who is tied for event Champion may shoot-off for the Championship trophy. If a shooter fails in the Championship trophy shoot-off and has declared a Special Category at classification, the shooter will fall back to his/her declared Category.
- # 6 Any shooter who has declared a Special Category at Classification and whose score qualifies him/her for any trophy in his/her declared Category will compete for the Category trophy and not for place, class or yardage group.
- # 7 Any Category shooter whose score doesn't qualify for a trophy in his/her Category may compete for place, class or yardage group. There will be no exceptions to this Rule.
- #8 Trophy ties in Events 1 and 3 will be carried over to the next like event by sub-event.

CHUCK CURTIS

It seems that Chuck Curtis has been hunting and shooting since he was born in 1920 in Harrisburg, Oregon. He grew up on a grass seed farm and has continued in the profession.

Chuck and Donna Curtis were married for 54 years before her passing in 1995. They had two daughters, Gloria and Shirley, both of whom became teachers.

In 1997, Chuck invited a fellow shooter, Virginia Bonser, out for lunch. Her husband, Norm Bonser, had passed away the previous year. The story has it that Virginia's Sister-in-Law was visiting from Chicago and chaperoned the two on their first date. Chuck and Virginia have been together ever since. They usually Winter in Tucson from October to April. During those months, they participate in the winter-chain shoots in the area.

Chuck has always believed in giving back to the organizations in which he participates. That is no difference with the ATA and PITA. He has worked tirelessly, helping with traps, buildings, roads, and landscaping in many shooting clubs in Oregon, Washington, Arizona, Alaska, Idaho, Nevada, California, Wyoming, Florida, and British Columbia. He would pitch in and help run shoots wherever he was needed.

Chuck is a life member of both the ATA and the PITA. He began serving on the PITA Executive Board in 1976. He served two terms as President in 1983 and 1984. He continued to serve in some capacity until 1994. He was inducted into the PITA Hall of Fame in 2006.

As for his shooting, there are many trophies in his home and spread throughout his family. He first reached the 27 yard line in 1976 in Tucson. As of this writing, he is shooting from the 24 yard line. From 1966-2014, Chuck has shot 58,000 targets in Singles, 82,325 in Handicap, and 34,800 in Doubles for a total of 175,125 ATA targets.

Two honors for which he is very proud are winning the High Over All A Class during one of the many winter chain shoots in Tucson, and winning the High Over All Elder in Oregon in 2002.

PHIL SHERRELL

Two time Oregon State ATA Handicap Champion and Oregon state trapshooting icon, Phil Sherrell, began registering ATA targets in 1968 and has amassed 47,950 Singles targets, 59,350 Handicap Targets, and 32,250 Doubles targets in his career to date. Phil has won a total of 25 trophies at the Oregon State ATA Championships since 1976, when he won his first handicap title. He repeated the handicap championship again 24 years later, in 2000. Phil was handicap champion runner-up in 1997. Between 1976 and 2012 there have been numerous category, class, and place finishes as well.

Phil has also claimed five non-resident trophies at the Washington State ATA Championships and another seven trophies at the Idaho State ATA Championships. There have been countless wins and trophies at local ATA and non-registered events within Oregon, Washington, and Idaho over Phil's 46 year ATA shooting career.

Phil was born in Portland, Oregon April 23, 1933 and spent his youth and early adult years in the thriving metropolis of Arlington, Oregon. Where his father operated a Chevrolet dealership. The family later relocated to Hermiston, Oregon where Phil's father assumed operation of another Chevrolet dealership—Sherrell Chevrolet, which is still in operation today. Phil served in the Army during the Korean Conflict and returned home to resume his role in the family business. Phil later left the car dealership and operated a beer distributorship for many years, eventually selling that and semi-retiring to his current career of property management, car washes, and storage units. Phil has two children, Allison and Steve who still live close to home.

During Phil's shooting career, he served for decade on the Hermiston Rod & Gun Club Board of Directors, served on the OSATA Board of Directors, and has helped at numerous OSATA Shoots and other regional and local events. Phil has shot and travelled with many Oregon trapshooting legends: Jack West, Tom Seitz, Mervin Swearingen, Pete and Dick Wheelhouse, The Jones' - Lawrence Sr., Kenny, and Lawrence, Jr., Jim Saddler, Larry Runyon, Enos & Daro Handy, and many other great competitors over the years.

Aside from the trophies, the wins, the service to the organizations, and the amazing number of friends Phil has in the trapshooting community, the most inspiring and gratifying element of Phil's shooting career is the number of youth shooters he personally has taken to the club and taught the fine sport of trapshooting, a trend he continues yet today. While many of these youth did not continue to compete, they all learned valuable life lessons in competition and sportsmanship. We all know Phil as a very humble champion in the trapshooting community and it is with great respect an honor that we are able to recognize Phil Sherrell as a true gentleman in every respect, and very deserving of his Oregon State ATA Hall of Fame Induction.
