GENERAL INFORMATION

The Annual General Meeting of the BCTA will be held in the clubhouse on Saturday, May 16th, 2015, at 0700, prior to the day's shooting.

Entry Fees will be in Canadian funds. All cheques payable to the BCTA. Due to our financial institution's regulations, no third party cheques will be accepted by the cashier. The US exchange rate will be posted with the cashier.

Refunds: No entry fees / options will be refunded after an event has started.

SQUADDING

Any one man squads may be required to shoot the last squad and will be assigned a referee. Two man squads will also be assigned a referee.

PRE-SQUADDING: Please contact Presquad.com or Peggy Bare at peggylebare@yahoo.ca or 250-768-3301

NOTE: We ask that shooters, whenever possible, avoid squadding on a late squad in the first event of the day then an early squad in the next event. We wish to operate with the least possible delay between events for your benefit.

Any shooter that has a yardage change after they have squadded on line must contact the cashier, Peggy Bare, as this could possibly necessitate resquadding.

The Canadian Firearms Act requires that all shooters must be in possession of a current Firearms License.

Non-Canadian Shooters: Canadian Firearms Declaration Permits are available at Canada Customs. The fee is \$25.00 Cdn.

GENERAL INFORMATION

SHOOTER RESPONSIBILITY

Your card must be up-to-date before presentation to the Classification Committee. The shooter must show both PITA & ATA average cards to determine Handicap Yardage assignment. Failure to comply with these rules may result in forfeiture of all monies and trophies. A shooter must shoot in the proper class and at the correct yardage. An error at the handicap table does not excuse any shooter from this responsibility of knowing the rules.

Any shooter not present for the 1st event for which they have pre-squadded, will forfeit their pre-squad for all remaining events. This is to prevent a vacant post for the entire program should a shooter be unable to attend due to unexpected circumstances and fails to contact the cashier.

NO MAKE UP FOR MISSING YOUR SQUAD WILL BE ALLOWED. If you miss your squad, report to the squad counter to be assigned a new squad on the same bank of traps. Make-ups for gun repairs must report to the squad counter and you will be required to shoot on the same bank of traps.

THREE MINUTE WAIT: Your squad will proceed without you and tardy shooters will not be allowed to shoot up, but will be re-squadded at the bottom of the list, if time permits. **After first squadding change a \$10 fee will be charged.**

TIES: With the exception of event 2, all ties in all events will be shot off unless all tied contestants agree to a carry over.

SPECIAL CATEGORIES: If you qualify in any special category-Lady, Veteran (65-69), Sr. Veteran (70-74), Elder (75 and over), Junior (15-17) or Sub-junior (under 15), please check your entry receipt and posted scores so they may be included in that competition.

CLUB TEAM NOTICE

Each club must be a member of the BCTA. Each team will be comprised of 5 BC resident shooters (PITA residency requirements). Any number of teams from each club may participate. It will be the responsibility of each club to form and enter their teams, using first and last name. The scores shot in the final handicap will be used to calculate the team totals. Five prizes will be given to the winning team.

CLUB TEAM MEMBERS MUST BE LISTED ON A SHEET PROVIDED ON THE NOTICE BOARD PRIOR TO 8:00 am ON MONDAY MORNING.

REGISTRATION

All Contestants must be members of the PITA for the current year. Annual membership fee is \$20.00 (first time PITA memberships are \$10.00, Life Membership is \$400.00) and will be payable when you register if a 2015 card cannot be produced. PITA daily fee \$3.00, BCTA fee 2 cents per target. **All new junior and new sub-junior shooters memberships will be paid by the PITA this year. All Junior and sub-junior shooters target fees will be paid for by the BCTA for the 2015 Championship Singles (events 4&5). Shooters will be eligible for added money, options and trophies in those events. (See NB under "Targets Only" below)**

V.G.C. - BC TRAPSHOOTING ASSOCIATION will not be responsible for any accident, or for any loss of property.

CROSS - REGISTERED TARGETS WITH ATA

Targets may be cross registered with ATA subject to all the fees, rules, and requirements.

ALL CONTENDERS FOR TWO IN A FAMILY AND HUSBAND & WIFE must enter their names and squad numbers on the sheets provided on the bulletin board prior to 9:00am Saturday before Event 4, BC Singles. The names will be verified by the BCTA Secretary. ALL scores will be entered by the cashier or the BCTA executive.

CLASS WINNERS AND TIES

Preliminary singles and doubles event winners and ties will not move up a class for the championship events.

TARGETS ONLY

Juniors and Sub-juniors may shoot for targets and trophies only at \$15.00 / 100 targets, but, at that rate, they are not eligible to win any added monies or enter any event options. NB. The computer 3-S programme cannot cope with mixed target fees. Therefore any shooter entering multiple events must pay a consistent fee for all events entered. At \$15/100, shooters, including new Juniors and Sub-Juniors will be eligible for trophies ONLY.

EARNED YARDAGE: If you earn yardage during the shoot, you must check with the office. It may be necessary to re-squad you.

PLEASE NOTE: Peggy Bare (250-768-3301) will be cashiering this shoot.

GENERAL INFORMATION

2015 PITA "ROOKIE OF THE YEAR" AWARD

All new British Columbia shooters who have not shot registered targets in any association until after the 2014 Provincial Shoot are eligible for the Provincial Rookie of the Year competition at the 2015 BC Provincial. The contestants must shoot the BC Singles Championships and the BC Handicap Championship, a total of 300 targets to qualify. The winner will be awarded a trophy and will be eligible to represent our Province at the Grand Pacific in July 2015 in the 2015 PITA ROOKIE OF THE YEAR competition. In the absence of the winner the runner up may compete. Travel assistance will be offered to our Provincial representative.

Should the State/Provincial Rookie Champion or Runner-up be absent from the Grand the person with the next highest score in attendance may represent that State/Province in the competition.

The PITA YES program will again be awarding five one-hundred dollar scholarships to the BC Juniors and Sub-Juniors as follows: High Youth Shooter / High Junior / High Junior Runner-up / High Sub-Junior / High Sub-Junior Runner-up.

BCTA SINGLES CHAMPION

Should the State/Provincial Singles Champion or Runner-up be absent from the Grand the person with the next highest score in attendance may represent that State/Province in the competition.

TARGET SETTING

A target setting committee appointed by the Executive Committee will set targets each morning according to PITA rules. Target setting changes will be made during an event only if the targets become illegal. **Resetting of targets must be authorized and checked only by a member of the target setting committee. No exceptions.**

SHOOT-OFFS

All shoot offs, if required, will follow the last registered event of the day. It is the shooters responsibility to be aware of any shoot off. Contestants who miss their shoot off will forfeit.

Special Hidden Score

Example

Of those shooters taking the option:

High Score - 96

Low score - 80

difference - 16

Numbers 0 to 16 placed in a hat and one number drawn (say 11)

Subtract that number from High Score (96 minus 11 = 85)

The (those) shooter(s) with a score of 85 takes (splits) the entire option.

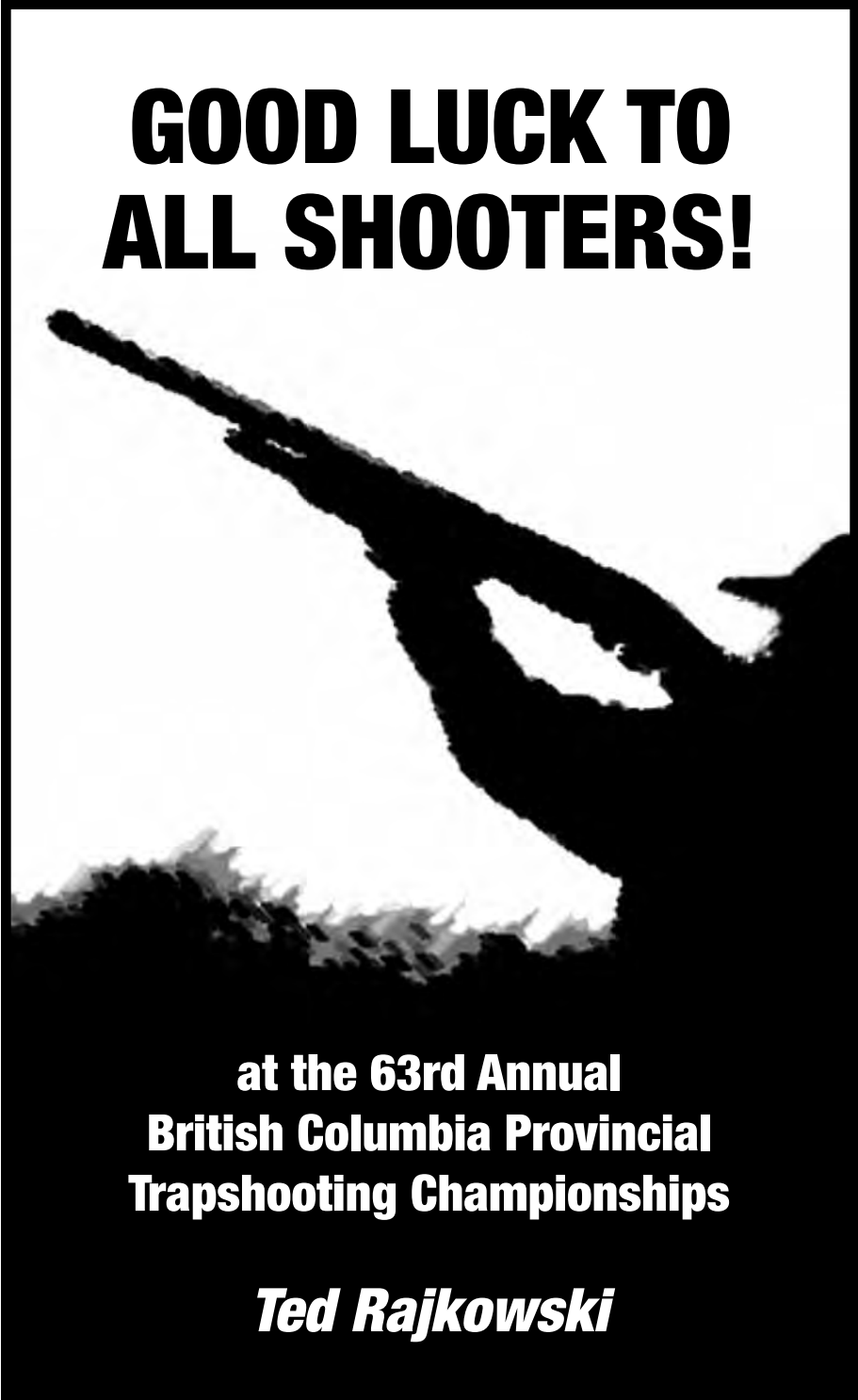

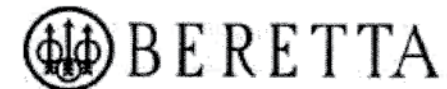
