In Memory of John Gilbert (Buck) Buckmaster

1916 – 2003

Buck was the driving force behind the building of the Boise Gun Club at its present Kuna-Mora Road location. He was club president during the construction, and along with Floyd Mercer, Al Lewis, and many others, donated great amounts of time, effort and resources to get the club built and operating. We held our first registered shoot here in 1972.

After serving in the military in World War Two, Buck began shooting trap in the late 1940's and throughout the 50's, 60's and early 70's was a fixture at shoots all over the West. A good shooter, Buck had many wins during his career. He served on the ISTA board of directors along with being on the Boise GC board many times.

When it became clear that the club would be moving, he was actively involved in the location and selection of a new site (Kuna-Mora), the sale of the Federal Way land, and the construction of the new club. This was a difficult job that had many setbacks. Money soon became short and it was only because of the loyal support, effort, and dedication of many club members that the job was finally finished. Buck helped with almost every part of the construction process. When the last of the night-lights were finally finished, Buck looked around and said: "I'm glad we're finished and I've built my last gun club."

After retiring in 1976 from B & B Electric, which he and a partner had started in the early 1950's, Buck enjoyed spending as much time as possible at the family cabin in Cascade. He was fun to hunt with, fun to shoot with, and fun to work with. It is because of the efforts of John Buckmaster and others like him that the Boise Gun club exists today. We miss you Buck, and we'll break a target for you at the shoot.

INFORMATION ON PROGRAM PURSES AND OPTIONS

Shooters – please understand that you do not have to enter any of the purses or options to shoot the events. They are there to add excitement to the game. MAKE SURE YOU UNDERSTAND HOW THEY WORK! To help you with this, there will be an information packet that you can pick up when you register for the shoot. This will also be posted at the scoreboard. For information on Lewis Options, handicap purses, and 25 and 50 handicap options refer to this handout.

JACKPOT OPTION

For this shoot there will be a Jackpot option on the handicap. This is offered for the more “adventurous” handicap shooters. The option will cost \$25 with all of the money going back to the shooters on that day. It will be paid 1 in 6 entries, high gun.

6 entries or less will pay: 100% high gun
7-12 entries will pay: 60%-40% high gun
13-18 entries will pay: 50%-30%-20% high gun
19 or more will pay: 30%-20%-30%-20% high gun
(This last pay-off spreads the money out a little bit more)

Entry for this non-compulsory perpetual option is \$3 for each 50 for a total of \$18. Entry fees collected at this shoot will be added to the respective purses for the next BGC shoot. Any two 25 straights win ONE-HALF of the respective purse. Each \$18 entry is eligible for one-half of any or all (i.e., 100 straight) of these perpetual purses. All ties for the day divide the respective monies.

IDAHO HALL OF FAME LEWIS PURSE

The PITA state association strongly supports the Idaho Trapshooting Hall of Fame. The Hall of Fame purses will be Lewis Class purses on the handicap events. They will cost \$10 and will be paid: one pay per 6 entries with 70% to the shooters and 30% donated to the Hall of Fame to help support and preserve the history of Idaho trapshooting. The \$3 donation is tax deductible and other cash donations are greatly appreciated.

This Certifies that the Boise Gun Club has been authorized to hold a registered PITA shoot at Boise, Idaho on February 22, 2015. PITA rules will apply. The Pacific International Trapshooting Association.

Cross Registration with the ATA available. Must shoot your longest yardage. Notify the handicapper and the cashier if you wish to cross register your targets.

If you are trying to make the Idaho PITA All-Star team, this is a shoot for you! There are a maximum of 21 All-Star win points available. For more information pick up an All-Star team flyer at the shoot.

NEED AN SRTA OR CAMAS PRAIRIE SCORE?? Come shoot with us this weekend and we will verify and call in your score to your club. Make sure you bring the phone number.

Draw Score Prizes on the Handicap. There will be a total of \$150 awarded on two different draw scores on the handicap event. The first score drawn will be for \$100 and the second score drawn will be for \$50. Since there is a good chance there will be ties, it is suggested that you hang around until the scores have been drawn at the conclusion of the handicap event. Ties will be shot off miss-and-out. **Thanks again to A.D. for the donation of these prizes in memory of the shooters, friends, and loved ones who passed away.**

TROPHY AND AWARD LIST. 45 AWARDS, TROPHIES AND DRAW PRIZES. FEBRUARY 22, 2015.

Event 1-100 Singles. Winner Each Class (AA-A-B-C-D) Lady, Veteran, Senior Veteran, Junior, Rookie and Rookie Runner-up. Draw team winners (5).

Event 2-100 Doubles. Winner Each Class (AA-A-B-C-D) Lady, Veteran, Senior Veteran, Junior and Rookie.

Event 3- Memorial Handicap. 100 Targets.

Champion . Winner of each of four yardage groups (18-21 ½, 22-24 ½, 25-26 ½ and 27 yards) Lady, Veteran, Senior Veteran, Junior, Rookie Winner, Rookie runner-up, and winners of the two draw scores.

H-O-A Awards. Champion and each H-O-A class winner (AA-A-B-C-D) will receive a H-O-A trophy pin from the PITA and a trophy plate from the Boise Gun Club.

SPECIAL NOTE! No Rookie may win more than two Rookie trophies for the day. For example, if a Rookie wins Rookie trophies in both events 1 and 2, then they could not win another Rookie trophy in event 3.

PROGRAM GENERAL INFORMATION

Singles and Doubles Classification

Singles – AA-97 and up. A-94.50 to 96.99. B-91.50 to 94.49.
C-88.50 to 91.49. D-Under 88.50%

Doubles – AA-93 and up. A-89 to 92.99. B-85 to 88.99
C-78 to 84.99. D-under 78%

Conduct and Program Changes. The Boise Gun Club reserves the right to refuse entry or withdraw any contestant who in any way interferes with the safety, harmony, and enjoyment of this shoot. The Boise Gun Club also reserves the right to change or alter any portion of this program at any time prior to or during this shoot.

Sign Up, Registration and Classification. Will start at 8:00 a.m. with shooting to start at 9:30. You will notice that we are having an extra-long registration time. This should make it so that shooters won't have to wait in line very long and we can start the shooting on time. **THIS WILL ONLY WORK IF SHOOTERS DON'T WAIT UNTIL THE LAST MINUTE TO SIGN UP.**

Empty Hulls. If you want your empties, please catch them. No one will be permitted to pick up empty hulls.

Awards. No shooter may win more than one trophy per event. You must notify the handicapper if you are a lady, junior, veteran, senior veteran, or rookie. No minimum number of shooters required for trophies to be awarded.

Boise Gun Club Yardsticks. If you get a yardage punch in the handicap, please see Kent Harris for your BGC yardstick.

Shoot-offs. All ties for trophies will be shot off. Ties on option money will be split. Be available or forfeit.

Kitchen. Will be open for this shoot. Chef Dale Ham.

Practice Trap. One practice trap will be open an hour before and during the shoot. Purchase practice tickets at the BGC cashier's window at member price.

Special Category Information. Veteran – 65 to 69. Senior Veteran – 70 and over. Junior- under 18. Rookie – Any shooter who has started shooting registered targets (either PITA or ATA) after the end of last year's PITA state shoot.

New Shooters. Less than 500 registered singles (PITA & ATA combined) shoot B class. Less than 200 doubles (PITA & ATA combined) shoot B class.

Straight Pins. First time PITA 25-50-75 straight pins will be available compliments of the State association for any shooters who qualify. PITA 100 straight and 27 yard pins to those who qualify, compliments of the parent PITA.

Directions to the Club - From the east take the Black's Creek-Kuna exit (64) off I-84 and travel west for 6 miles. From the west exit I-84 at the Orchard Ave. exit (52) and go south on Orchard around the airport to Pleasant Valley Rd. Then travel south for 6 miles to Kuna-Mora Rd. and then go east one mile.
