
WWGC On-Line Program 2015

Notes:

- I) This program is the same as the mailed version, except that quite a few ads have hyperlinks which will allow you to click on them and go directly to their respective websites. How cool is that?
- 2) You will notice that the pages in this booklet seem out of order. That's because they are set up to print out into a booklet, with pages that stack one on top of another.
- 3) If you want to print this program so that it looks like the mailed version, do the following:
- a) click File>Print or <ctrl>p, and open up your print setup page.
- b) select to print pages 1-9, and then click on the tab or the drop-down box that says "Odd Pages Only."
 - c) click Print
- d) when pages are printed, DO NOT re-order the pages. Instead, turn the whole stack of pages over just as they are, replace them into the paper tray. Be sure that the top of the printed pages are on the left side of the tray or paper cassette (for most printers, some may differ).
- e) click File>Print or <ctrl>p, and open up your print setup page.
- f)select to print pages 2-10, and then click on the tab or the drop-down box that says "Even Pages Only."
 - g) check the box that says "Reverse Order."
 - c) click Print

You should have a stack of pages that you can fold, staple, and take with you.

SHOOT NOTES GOVERNING ALL SHOOTS

- I. ATA RULES govern registered shoots at all times. Walla Walla Gun Club rules govern all other shoots & events.
- 2. All contestants, scorers, target setters, referees, and anyone else on the firing line must wear eye and ear protection at all times. No exceptions.
- 3. No option money will be refunded after event has begun.
- 4. JUNIORS & SUB-JUNIORS may opt out of compulsory purses for any Non-Registered Money Shoot (pp 10-11).
- 5. Unless stated here otherwise, all ties for purses and option money divide, and all ties for trophies will be settled by shoot-off. Please be aware that anyone not answering the call for shoot-off within a 10-minute period will forfeit their shoot-off opportunity.
- 6. Targets are thrown from automatic machines only. Machines will be set by shoot committee before shooting starts each day, and will not be reset unless conditions change or equipment fails such that targets are illegal. No one except tournament committee members may touch traps once they are set. No exceptions.
- 7. Walla Walla Gun Club reserves the right to remove and/ or disqualify anyone who interferes with the conduct of our shoots, with forfeiture of entry and purse money. This includes anyone who is abusive to trap or Gun Club officials, or anyone exhibiting unsportsmanlike conduct.
- 8. Management reserves the right to modify this program wholly or in part at any time right up until events begin. All fees posted in this booklet are accurate at press time, but are subject to change.
- It is the shooter's responsibility to shoot his/her correct class and yardage. Any yardage punches and/or class advances from a previous day's shooting must be declared and observed prior to event or shooter will forfeit entry and purse money.


