UPCOMING EVENTS

MULTIPLEX SHOOT; On Tuesday, August 5th will be our final PITA MultiPlex shoot. This is a 50 Singles, 50 Handicap and 25 pair Doubles where we are competing against multiple gun clubs in the lower 48. The July results will be given in the Past Events portion of this newsletter.

The months PITA MultiPlex Shoot date has been changed from Wednesday, August 6th to Tuesday, August 5th, 2014. The open range time will start at 5:00pm and end with the last participant. This date and time change has been made due to the great turn-out we had at the June shoot; to give all shooters a little more time for the event. Remember this is a PITA, nationwide event with participants able to shoot 50 Singles, 50 Handicap and 25 pair of Doubles. You can enter one event or all three events. We are competing against other gun clubs and for Lewis Class winnings. So far for June and July, we have had many of our members win or tie other club scores and win Lewis Class prizes.

If any member has a problem shooting on Tuesday, please let me know and we will arrange for another date and time. All scores must be reported on or before Friday, August 8th.

AUGUST 9TH, REGISTERED TRAP SHOOT; Saturday, August 9 is our "normal", second Saturday of the month registered trap shoot. This month's event will be an A.T.A., 300 target shoot

consisting of 100 Singles, 100 Handicap and 50 pair of Doubles. Participants can shoot one, two or all three events. Sign-up registration and set-up is from 8:30 to 9:25am. For new shooters, a safety meeting will be held. The first squad will be called to their posts at 9:30am.

As always, P.I.T.A. cross registration is allowed with a \$6.00 cross registration fee. The entry fee for the first 100 targets is \$25.00 and then \$15.00 for each additional 100 targets. Junior shooters will be half the above cost. As always it's a great time. Show-up and participate.

AUGUST-SEPTEMBER HANDICAP & WOBBLES LEAGUE; Water fowl season will start on Tuesday, September 16th, 2014. Per the last several years, JGC has held a one month, handicap and wobbles league to sharpen the waterfowl hunter's hand-eye-shot coordination as well as the trap shooter for that opening.

The league will begin on Sunday, August 24th and end Sunday September 14th, two days in advance of the waterfowl opener for the greater Juneau area. The league is open to JGC members and non-members alike. Normal trap fees applied to each individual entering the league. The league entry fee will be \$20. The fee is used as the "winners" prize. Winners will be the "outright winner", the runner up, the "middle" of the "pack" individual and the red lantern winner. The winner will collect 40% of the entry fees; runner up 30%, while 20% and 10% will go to the "middle of the pack shooter" and the red lantern winner.

Come sharpen your hand-eye-shooting coordination's. This league is great fun, join us!
