UNCOMING EVENTS;

MultiPlex Shoot; The July PITA MultiPlex Shoot date has been changed “from” Wednesday, July 2nd “to” Tuesday, July 1st, 2014. The open range time will start at 5:00pm and end with the last participant.

This date and time change has been made due to the great turn-out we had at the June shoot; to give all shooters a little more time for the event and to be more open for other holiday activities during the 4th of July long weekend. Remember this is a PITA, nationwide event with participants able to shoot 50 Singles, 50 Handicap and 25 pair of Doubles. You can enter one event or all three events. We are competing against other gun clubs and for Lewis Class winnings.

July 4th, Celebration; Happy 4th of July to all. Enjoy the long weekend, the Juneau and Douglas Parades and all the “Who-Ra-Ra” for this great weekend.

JGC July Registered Shoot; The club’s second Saturday of the month (July 12th) registered trap shoot will be the Tom Freeman Memorial Singles event. This will be 300 singles shot in 100 target groups. Participants can enter to shoot 100, 200 or all 300 targets. Class awards will only be presented to those shooters completed all 300 targets.

The entry fee will be \$25 for the first 100 targets and \$15 for each additional targets. Sign-up and squad assignments will be from 8:30 to 9:30am. A safety meeting will be held for first time participants. The first squad will go to their posts at 9:30am.

Alaska State Amateur Trap Association (ATA) Championship; The Alaska State ATA Championship will be held at Birchwood Alaska from Wednesday, July 16th through Sunday, July 20th. This will be a 1,300 target event. A flyer has been sent, via email, to all JGC members. A copy of the flyer will be at the club house. If you are going to attend and drive to Anchorage/Birchwood with your shotgun and ammo, please take along a copy of the flyer to assist you in explaining to customs, why so much ammo is needed.

Pacific Northwest Grand Trap Shooting Championship; This event is held at Evergreen Shooting Park, near Olympia, Washington from July 20th through July 26th .

This is a true weeklong tournament shooting from 200 to 300 targets per day. Again flyers are at the club. If interested, see Jay Davis at the club. He is one of the tournament officials.

The Alaska state PITA trap shoot; This 5 day event was held at the Fairbanks Trap Club from Wednesday, June 11th to Sunday, June 15th, 2014. Seven JGC club members participated in the shoot that had 12 events. Two of the JGC members were from communities, other the Juneau. Mike McConahy is from Fairbanks and Dave Kaiser is from Wasilla. Between 30 and 50+ trap shooters participated. Some participants were from out-of-state and one was from Canada.

The Yukon Territory is part of the PITA Alaska Region. Wednesday is the preliminary shoot day with the state championship being from Thursday through Sunday. Wednesday Through Sunday there is 3 events per day with each event being 100 targets. On Saturday, the state singles championship consists of 200 targets from 16 yards. On Sunday, the stae Handicap and Doubles championship is held. Handicap consists of 100 targets from the participants earned yardage. Doubles consists of 50 pair of targets.

The weather was “real Alaska”. The temperatures ran 20°F colder then the recorded normal temperatures. For fun rain and wind was added on several days. For the first few squads of Fridays Doubles, the wind blew about 20mph with gusts to about 40mph. Shooters had a hard time standing. But, believe it or not, it was FUN! For the later squads the wind died down (darn-it).
