WEDNESDAY, DECEMBER 31, 2014; To all of our members and their guests, please be advised that the Juneau Gun Club will be closed for Wednesday night shooting, December 31, 2014.

JANUARY 3RD PITA MULTIPLEX; On Saturday, January 3rd we will shoot our 4th in a series of 5 PITA registered MultiPlex events. If you haven't participated, these are a 150 round registered shoot in which our club participates against other Pacific Northwest clubs in a Lewis Class Shoot. We shoot 50 Singles, 50 Handicap and 25 pair of Doubles. Sign-up, squad assignments and range setup is 8:30 to 9:25am. If there are any new shooters, a safety meeting will follow. The first firing squad is to their post at 9:30am. The first event will be singles, followed by Handicap and then Doubles. You may elect to shoot one, two or all three events.

JANUARY 8TH WINTER LEAGUE CONTINUE'S; Although it will be the 3rd week of the 2014-15 Winter League, for four teams it will only be the 2nd week of shooting. JANUARY 10TH PITA REGISTERED TRAP SHOOT; On the second Saturday of January we will participate in our regular monthly 300 target registered trap event. Sign-up, post set-up and squading will be from 8:30am to 9:25am. A safety meeting will follow for new shooters. The first firing squad will be to the 16 yard trap line at 9:30am. Shooting will be 100 Singles, shot first, followed by 100 Handicap and ending with 50 pair of Doubles. You may shoot 1, 2 or all 3 events. The registration fee for the first 100 targets is \$25. For each following 100 targets the fee is \$15.00. Come one, come all and have fun.

DECEMBER REGISTERED ATA SHOOT RESULTS; The December 13th registered A.T.A. trap shoot found Juneau in a very unseasonably warm, but very dark day. Temperatures varied from a low of 34°F to 41°F, but the day was so dark for both the first and third events (Singles and Doubles) that the outdoor field lights were of little help. A light fog and rain occurred during event two, Handicap. Eight members started the day with five finishing. The results were;

Event 2, Handicap, 7 Entries, Light rain, fog & dark; Short Yardage, Doug Jones, 86/100, event and class winner; Jerry Godkins, 82/100; Fred Wilson, 79/100; Victor Winters, 59/100 and Mar’chant Thompson, 52/100. Mid Yardage, Hank Masters, 87/100, class winner; Mal Menzies, 81/100.

Event 3, Handicap, 5 Entries, Very Dark conditions; “B” Class, Jay Davis, 78/100, event and class winner; “C” Class, Mal Menzies, 64/100, class winner; Fred Wilson, 63/100; Victor Winters, 54/100 and Mar’chant Thompson, 53/100.
