Fall is a great time to be shooting in Idaho. Good luck to those of you chasing birds and big game in the great Idaho outdoors.

September saw a very good turn-out at the Twin Falls Shooter Appreciation shoot September 16th and 17th and we kicked off the last PITA registered shooting of the target year with the October Multiplex shoots on October 7th and 8th. Here are the results, winners, and high scores from these events.

Idaho Shooter Appreciation Shoot. September 16th and 17th, 2017. Twin Falls Gun Club.

66 shooters enjoyed two beautiful fall days of shooting as they fired at 28,700 registered targets. Wade Mason edged Chuck Terry by one target to take the singles championship with his 199. Scott Abo won the doubles championship with his lone 96. Gary Jones won a four- way shoot-off of 93's to win the first handicap and Brian Lancaster was high in the Preliminary handicap with his 97. Jim Cahoon won the handicap championship by three birds as his 97 topped six scores of 94. Jeff Wright was the HOA champion with 570 as he finished two birds ahead of Stan Welton.

Gary Jones earned his PITA 27 yard pin, Wade Mason got his first 100 straight PITA pin, and Elizabeth Newland qualified for her Idaho 25 straight pin.
