2017 Idaho PITA State Shoot. Boise Gun Club. June 9th – 11th.

113 shooters from Idaho, Washington, Oregon, California, Nevada, and Utah almost avoided all of the bad weather that was in the area for the weekend. There were about 25 minutes of good wind and a 20 minute drizzle – both on Sunday. The shooters fired at 64,800 registered birds which was an increase of 13% from the previous state shoot.

Jeff Wright captured the singles championship with 197 and a shoot-off win over Jim Fultz and Gail Jones. Wright also won the H-O-A championship by eight birds over Mike Lacey when he blasted 757.

Stuart Welton won the doubles championship with 96 after a tie with Mike Lacey, Kent Harris and Wayne McCulley and was all alone in the handicap championship with his 97. Jeff Scott was the H-A-A champ with his 379. He edged Lacey, Wright, and Waylon Klundt by two targets.

Welton also won the Bob Murphey Memorial Preliminary doubles with a fine 99. John Kelner had a near perfect 99 in the J.O. Cotant handicap missing one target on his first trap and Rich Bullard won a shoot-off of 95's over Dave Kelly and Darel Holcomb to win the buckle for the Ron Veatch Memorial handicap.

Shooters and their guests were treated to two meals, a Texas Hold 'Em tournament, draw score shoot-offs for cash prizes and other activities during the weekend.

19th Annual Silver Buckle Shoot. Pocatello Trap Club. June 17 and 18, 2017.

51 shooters took advantage of nice weather and fired at just over 20,000 registered targets. The wind was “friendly” this

weekend as the scores were good in all events. Jackie Morris had the lone 100 straight on the Saturday singles and Todd Delong was the only one perfect on the Sunday singles.

Scott Webster won two of the three handicap events with his 98 all alone in the preliminary handicap and his 96 giving him the win in the final handicap after a shoot-off with Devin Devore and Morris. The Saturday handicap was led by Jim Cahoon as his almost perfect 99 topped Ray Ogle by two birds.

In the 200 bird doubles race Kent Harris led the first hundred with his 96 and Delong was high in the second hundred with 97. Both shooters had a perfect 50 trap during the event. Harris took the win on the total 200 with his 191, three better than Delong. Harris also won the HOA champion's pin with his 669 score which led the field by 13 birds.

Several shooters earned their Idaho PITA straight pins at the shoot. Gerald Cox, Zack Moedl, and Chris Payne all earned their 25 pin. Scott Webster got his 25, 50, and 75 straight pins and Morris was awarded his PITA 100 straight pin.
