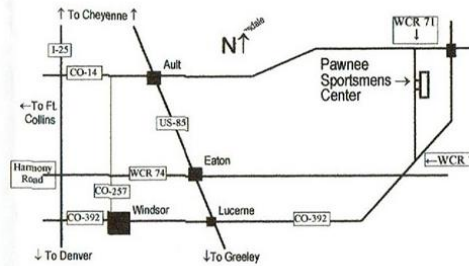

**HWY 14 Access:** 13 mi. east of I-25 to Ault\*. Continue 19 mi. east of Ault to WCR 71. Go south 3 mi. to PSC North (Rifle/Pistol) Entrance or 3.5 mi to PSC South (Clays) Entrance, East side of road.

**WCR 74 Access:** 15 mi. east of I-25 to Eaton\*. Continue 17 mi. east of Eaton to HWY 392. Go northeast 1.7 mi to WCR 71. Go north 3.5 mi to South (Clays) Entrance or 4 mi. to North (Rifle/Pistol) Entrance, East side of road.

**HWY 392 Access:** 15 mi. east of I-25 thru Windsor to Lucerne\*. Continue 18 mi. east/northeast to WCR 71. Go north 3.5 mi to South (Clays) Entrance or 4 mi. to North (Rifle/Pistol) Entrance, East side of road.
