The first quarter of the year saw the usual winter weather for Idaho with not much registered shooting taking place. There were two Multiplex shoots and Boise held their annual Buckmaster Memorial shoot. The SRTA league also started and shooting ramps up in April with the state association doubles marathon (500 targets) in Twin Falls on April 8th, followed two weeks later by the SRTA Championship shoot also at Twin on April 21st and 22nd. The last shoot of April will be held at Wood River on Saturday, April 28th.

Here are the results, high scores, and winners from the Multiplex shoots and the March 4th Boise shoot.
