April was a busy shooting month for the PITA in Idaho with the Doubles Marathon at Twin Falls, the SRTA Championships at Twin and the annual Wood River Gun Club Spring shoot. The members of the Idaho PITA All-Star team were also announced.

28 shooters braved breezy conditions to fire at 12,800 registered targets. The program consisted of 500 doubles targets with most trophies based on a shooter's best 300 bird total.

Brian Lancaster fired the best score of the day with a 94 in the third event on his way to topping all shooters on the best 300 total with his 275 score. Bob Clement won the PITA HOA champion's pin as his 450 score edged Jeff Wright by two targets.

A large crowd of 94 shooters enjoyed a very nice weekend and fired at 38,300 registered targets.

Jeff Wright was the singles champion with a lone 198 as he bested Jim Cahoon by one. Wright also took the High-Over-All championship as he won a coin toss over Scott Abo after a tie of 465 scores.

The preliminary handicap saw a four-way tie of 93's between Mike Chatterton, Tom Kirkdorffer, Isaiah Rosa, and Joe Nelson. Chatterton came back the next day and won the handicap championship all alone with his 97.

Randy Adams was 5 birds ahead of the field as he took the doubles championship with a very nice 98.

Kim Lickley won the "Best of the Best" Rookie Miss-and-out shoot off as fourteen rookies took part. Kim blasted 9 in a row.
