Caldwell had a perfect day with a good crowd and high scores, while the Handicap Marathon the next weekend in Pocatello was blasted by wind and weather. The Treasure Valley Singles Marathon at Boise the following Sunday had to wait out a heavy rainstorm before starting and then had good weather the rest of the day.

47 shooters took advantage of a beautiful day and fired at 10,900 registered targets.

Chester Carter sacked up a bunch of wins as he dominated the shoot. He won the doubles with a near perfect 99, won the handicap with a lone 97, and was the HOA champion with a fantastic 295 score. Dennis Agenbroad topped the singles with the lone 100 and it was his first perfect score.

25th Annual Treasure Valley Singles Marathon. Boise Gun Club. May 20th, 2018.

With a weather forecast for a nice morning but a stormy afternoon, shooters were surprised to have a heavy thundershower delay the start of shooting for about 30 minutes. The weather for the rest of the

day was much better than expected.
13,200 registered birds were shot.

Ray Ogle from Pocatello took the coveted personalized HOA champion's buckle with a score of 490 as he edged Waylon Klundt by one target. Guy Johnson – champion the last two years – started slow but broke 398 of the last 400 to win the buckle for the high score on your best 300 with 299. It would have been a perfect 300 but he got a blooper on his last event where the wad cleared the barrel. Johnson was breaking his first 200 straight ever with perfect scores on events 3 and 4. Jim Fultz fired at (and broke) his 50,000th PITA target in event 5 Colten Harrsch also earned his Idaho PITA 25 straight pin.

Rick Erickson had the high score in event 1 with his lone 99. Ogle and Gail Jones had perfect 100's to top event two while Johnson had the only 100's in events 3 and 4. Leonard Wehking and Johnson were at the top of event 5 with 99's.
