June was a big month for registered shooting in Idaho. The summer Multiplex shoots started, Twin Falls held their Canyon Classic shoot June 16th and 17th, Pocatello put on their annual Silver Shoot on the 23rd and 24th, and the Idaho State shoot was held back at Twin on June 29 – 30 and July 1.

**Twin Falls Canyon Classic and Dave
Clairborne Memorial Shoot. June 16-17,**

There were 61 shooters who shot 29,700 registered targets on a very nice weekend which resulted in high scores.

Stuart Welton captured the singles championship as his 199 edged Jim Cahoon by one target. Welton also won the doubles with a near perfect 99 and was the HOA champion with a score of 580 out of 600.

Patrick Curtis topped the championship handicap as his 96 was one bird over Pete Miller and Chester Carter. Christopher Payne had the high handicap score for the weekend as his 99 was 3 birds ahead on the Saturday handicap while Tom Kirkdorffer, Isaiah Rosa and Welton has 94's to lead in the Sunday preliminary handicap.

Chris Payne earned his Idaho 75 straight pin and Devin Devore qualified for his Idaho 50 straight pin. Jim Cahoon reached his PITA 50,000 target milestone at the shoot.

breeze Saturday with much less wind on Sunday.

Chester Carter and Lloyd Herbst led the scoring on the 200 bird doubles event with their 185's. John Berthelson broke the only perfect score in Saturday's singles and Berthelson and Greg Knuepel were high with their 90's in the Saturday Handicap.

Knuepel then shot the only 100 in the Sunday singles while Randy Ranstrom was high in the Preliminary handicap with 96. Rick Ruggles topped the main handicap by three birds with his 98 and Ruggles, Herbst, and Berthelson tied for the HOA as they all shot 648 X 700. Titus Lowe earned his Idaho 25 straight pin.

127 shooters from Idaho, Nevada, California, Washington, and Oregon enjoyed a weekend you want for a state shoot – not too hot and not too cold – just right. There was a breeze and it was cool on Friday but Saturday and Sunday were perfect as shooters fired at 76,100 registered targets.

Stuart Welton was all over the winner's list as he won the Martha Dixon Handicap on Friday with a lone 95 and then took the Mike Rinard Memorial Doubles on Friday with a top score of 96. He then won a yardage group award on the J.O. Cotant handicap on Saturday and then Sunday swept the doubles championship with 99, the handicap championship with 98, the HAA with 394 and the HOA with 777.

Chester Carter kept Welton from sweeping all five major championships as he won the Singles Championship with 198 after a

shoot-off with Brian Lancaster and Spud Storey.
