61 shooters fired at 27,600 registered targets under cloudy skies but with nice shooting conditions.

Brennon Braegger took the singles championship, winning a one-round shoot-off over Jeff Wright and Waylon Klundt after their tie at 197. Junior shooter Isaiah Rosa won the Saturday handicap by 2 birds with his lone 99.

Sunday, Casey Evans was the doubles champion, winning a shoot-off over Scott Abo after they both fired 98's. Abo then topped the Preliminary handicap with a 98 while Evans won the handicap Championship with 98 and also led the scoring for High-Over-All Champion with a very nice 576.
