Win points from ATA shoots will be given as long as those targets are properly cross registered to the PITA and the wins are reported to the selection committee by the end of the target year. **It will be the shooter's responsibility to report any wins at ATA shoots. It is also the shooter's responsibility to report any PITA wins at shoots outside of Idaho (except for the Grand Pacific.**
