This OT2 will cover the results of the first shoot of the calendar year – the Buckmaster memorial shoot at Boise in March, and then the April shoots at Twin Falls (doubles marathon on April 7), the Wood River Spring shoot on April 20, and the SRTA championship shoot April 27-28 back at Twin Falls.

### SIXTEENTH ANNUAL BUCKMASTER MEMORIAL SHOOT. BOISE GUN CLUB. MARCH 3RD, 2019.

After three weeks of cold, wet, and windy weather, 63 shooters got a day that was cool, calm, and dry. They made the best of their good fortune and fired at 14,700 registered targets with some very nice scores for this early in the year.

Bob Clement broke a very nice 98 to lead the doubles event by four birds. In the singles Colten Harrsch and Stuart Welton had perfect 100's. Welton also edged out Clement by one bird with his 287 to take the PITA HOA champion's pin. Anthony Barraco Jr. then beat Welton by a bird to win the handicap with his 94.

The 100 straight was the first for Harrsch and Logan Kaylor also earned his Idaho PITA 25 straight pin.
