HOW DOES A CLUB OR STATE/PROVINCE JOIN PITA?

Forming a new State/Provincial Association:

The interested parties must have at least three persons that are or will become PITA members.

They must elect or otherwise select three officers, (recently clarified that the three members and the three officers may be the same).

Construct their Association Bylaws. They usually use an existing State's bylaws as a guideline; we recommend keeping it simple and easily modified. The Association establishes any membership or daily fees they wish.

Apply for recognition by PITA and confirm their existence annually.

If planning to offer cross registration to ATA they must present an annual State/Provincial Shoot which must contain the HAA events, 100 handicap, 200 singles and 100 doubles.

Comply with all PITA rules. Encouraged to send two (or more if qualified by membership) delegates to the annual meeting (Grand).

A State/Provincial Association receives a portion of daily fees collected by PITA, may offer cross registration to ATA (upon meeting cross registration requirements) and may conduct multiplex events. There are no fees for becoming a new State/Provincial Association.

Individual Club wishing to host PITA events without a State/Provincial Association:

A Club wishing to host PITA events must first affiliate with an existing State/Provincial Association.

Affiliation must be recognized by PITA.

A Club affiliating is liable for any daily fees, membership or other fees the host Association collects unless other arrangements are agreed upon. Current fees are:

OSTA (OR)	2 cents/target
WS PITA (WA)	1.5 cents/target

Affiliated Clubs do not share in the return of PITA daily fees and are not represented at the annual Association meeting. They are not eligible to offer cross registration to ATA but may conduct Multiplex events.

They must follow all PITA rules when hosting PITA registered events.
