Spring Shoot at Caldwell. May 4th, 2019.

53 shooters took advantage of nice weather to shoot some very good scores and register 12,900 targets.

Jed Yore won a shoot-off of 97's over Colten Harrsch to top the doubles event. The singles had four shooters with 99's. Chester Carter, Chuck Terry, Chris Felty, and Kirk Bork all were almost perfect.

In the handicap, junior shooter Evan Arnold blasted a 99 score to take the championship. He was followed by Stuart Welton with 97 and Darel Holcomb with 96. Harrsch shot 290 and took the HOA champion's pin by two targets over Arnold.

It was a rare spring day with warm temperatures and very little wind. 43 shooters turned out and registered 14,300 targets.

Clay Brown won the champion's trophy on the total of the 300 handicap targets as he edged Devin Devore by one target with his 284. Clay also took the HOA champion's pin on the 400 birds as his 378 was three better than Jeff Wright. Brown finished the day winning his class in the doubles event winning a shoot-off of 94's over Eric Anderson.

Rick Ruggles earned his 27 yard PITA pin with a first - time punch to 27 for the high score of 96 in the first handicap. Devore was all alone at 97 in the second handicap and Wright fired a perfect 25 in the shoot-off to best Chris Payne after they had tied with 97's in the final handicap.

Randy Adams and Waylon Klundt took their classes with their 95's to lead the doubles event.
