The month was capped off with the Idaho PITA State Shoot at Caldwell from the 28th through the 30th.

Clay Brown topped the windy singles on Saturday with his 193, won his class in doubles and also took A class HOA. Rick Erickson was high in the Saturday Handicap with 94 from 27 yards and Jeff Wright won the HOA champion's pin with his 558 which edged Brown and Chester Carter by 2 birds.

Sunday was pretty much the Stuart Welton show as he won the doubles by one over Jeff Wright with a 98 and then won both handicaps. Welton fired a 98 in the preliminary handicap to top Wright and Paul Smith by 4 targets and then had 99 in the Championship handicap to win by 3 over Rookie Smith and Junior Evan Arnold.

Attendance was good with 71 shooter firing at over 31,000 registered birds. Lexi Nachtman earned her Idaho PITA 25 straight pin.

Annual Silver Shoot. Pocatello Trap Club. June 15-16, 2019.

46 shooters enjoyed very nice weather for two days and fired at over 20,000 registered targets. Lucas Piquet, Travis Dayley, and Tina Wright all earned their Idaho PITA 50 straight pins while Casey Evans shot his first PITA 100 and also qualified for his 27 yard PITA pin.

Jeff Wright took the doubles championship with 193 of 200. He had the high score on the first half with 97 while Brian Lancaster's 97 was high on the second half. Kelly Fairbanks had the lone 100 on the Saturday singles event and Wright led in the handicap on Saturday with his 97.

Sunday saw a trio of 100's in the singles with Waylon Klundt winning the shoot-off over Evans and Wright. In the preliminary handicap Tina Wright blasted 98 to win by one over Evans and her husband Jeff.

Junior shooter Mason Ward took the state handicap with his lone 98 and also was the HAA champion with his 381 score. Steve Spencer put a pair of 99's together for the only 198 in-state for the singles championship, and Colten Harrsch was the state doubles champion with 96. Waylon Klundt was the HOA champion with his 757 score as he topped Ward by four targets.
