The Young Family Memorial Shoot at Boise on October 4th, the Multiplex on October 7th, and the Friends of the NRA shoot at Caldwell on October 17th, closed out the target year for the PITA in Idaho.

Considering the problems Covid caused, it was pretty remarkable that only one shoot originally scheduled for 2020 was not rescheduled and shot. We did lose two Multiplex shoots however.

Here is a recap of the PITA shooting in Idaho for the month of October.

Young Family Memorial Shoot. Boise Gun Club. October 4th.

46 shooters took advantage of a beautiful Fall day and fired at 12,200 registered targets for the day.

In the doubles event Russell Pierce, Dave Poseley, and Chester Carter led the field with 95's. Pierce had a 20 to win a s.o. For AA with Carter, while Poseley took A class.

Singles scores were topped by 99's from Waylon Klundt who took AA, and Tony Shuyler and Carter in A class. Shuyler won a two round s.o.

Shuyler came back in the handicap with a 97 to win by two over runner-up Colten Harrsch. Pierce edged out Carter by two

targets to take the HOA champion's pin with a score of 285 X 300.
