

Registration

All contestants must be members of the P.I.T.A. for the current year.

If you have not paid your 2021 Dues then please do so BEFORE the shoot, and activate your shoot record.

\$4.00. B.C.T.A. Fee: 3 cents per target. Decision of management will be final in all matters not covered by the P.I.T.A. rulebook.

Shoot Offs

All ties for trophies & championships will be shot off the day the last event is finished. If you are in involved in a tie of this nature you MUST be on the grounds when your shoot off is called or otherwise forfeit all rights therein.

Championship Events

Any shooter who has not shot at least 300 PITA registered targets at 16 yards and 100 targets in doubles in the current and previous year, shall not shoot in less than "A" class singles and "B" class doubles. Also any shooter that has not shot at least 300 PITA registered targets in handicap during that same period, must shoot at no less than 22 yards. Ladies and sub-juniors must shoot at no less than 20 yards.

Except ladies & vets & all others, 500 sngs, 500 hdcp, 200 doubles.



This tournament shall be conducted in advance with the rules and regulations of the PACIFIC INTERNATIONAL TRAPSHOOTING ASSOCIATION.

Classification and Handicap Committee

The committee shall consist of District Reps.

Each contestant must first present himself or herself to this Committee for classification and handicapping.

The decisions of the Committee pertaining to Classification and handicapping shall be final. The Committee reserves the right to RECLASSIFY any shooter at any time during the program.

Handicap

All shooters will be assigned their yardage by the Official Handicap Committee. The current P.I.T.A. rules shall govern.

No shooters of more than 3 yards difference will be placed in the same handicap squad with no more than 2 yards between adjacent posts.




