55 shooters enjoyed good weather and registered 23,700 targets for the weekend.

Kelsey Wickham had a fantastic shoot. She won the first two handicaps and was third in the last handicap. She was also the junior singles winner, tied Clay Brown for the HO champion's pin with a 557 score, and won the Golden Pheasant buckle for the combined score of 193 on events 2 and 5.

Kyle Perry won a three way shoot-off of 196's over David Poseley and Darel Holcomb to claim the Singles Championship while Breyer Meeks was the Doubles Champ after a shoot-off of 95's with George Stevens. Gwendolyn Houser bested Jack Mitchell by one

37 shooters enjoyed very nice shooting weather to register 16,600 targets. Breaking the only 100's of the weekend were Mason Ward on Saturday and Mike Mowers on Sunday (his first). Jake Nelson earned his Idaho PITA 50 pin and Kelsey Wickham got her 75 straight pin in the first handicap.

Bodie Johnson led the scoring on the 200 doubles with his 189 score. Waylon Klundt was high on the 200 singles with 197. Kelsey Wickham blasted 98 in the first handicap, Jake Nelson was high in the second handicap with his 97 and Nico Elardi led in the final handicap with a 95 and used that score to win the HOA champion's pin by 2 birds with his 661 total.

Idaho PITA State Shoot. June 25-27, 2021. Boise Gun Club.

116 shooters fired at over 65,000 registered targets on a weekend with very warm temperatures and an unusual amount of breezy conditions.

Russell Pierce captured his first Idaho state championships by winning the HOA by one bird over Jack Nelson and taking the HAA by two targets over Kyle Perry. Pierce fired scores of 754 and 387. He also tied for the state doubles championship with 99 but lost a shoot-off 79 – 80 to Stuart Welton.

Clay Brown earned the singles championship for his first state title also as he put a pair of 99's together to tie David Poseley who took state-R-U.

Brian Lancaster won the state handicap championship as his 97 edged Mike Clark and Leonard Wehking by a bird. Non-resident Alexis Haggard from Nevada also fired a 97.
