Range opens at 8:00 am Thursday, February 17, 2022. The cashier's table opens at 8:30 am for registration.

GOVERNANCE

This tournament will be governed by the rules printed in this program and the current Pacific International Trapshooting Association (PITA) Rule Book. All shooters participating in this tournament agree to accept the official decisions and abide by the rules of the PITA. The PITA daily fee is \$4.00 and the Hawaii Pacific International Trap Association (HPITA) daily fee of \$3.00 will be collected on the first event entered each day. All contestants must be current members of the PITA. The annual membership fee is payable at registration.

The total number of shooters in this tournament is limited to sixty-five (65). Big Island Trap Club (BITC) reserves the right to refuse to refund any entry that in their judgement would interfere with the harmony of the shoot. BITC reserves the right to change all or any part of this program. Only personnel designated by club management may adjust targets.

Hawaii Pacific International Trap Association (HPITA) will host a PITA registered shoot on February 17-20, 2022. Targets may be cross-registered with the Amateur Trapshooting

Association (ATA) subject to all fees, rules, and requirements. Cross registration fees must be paid for all registered events in the tournament in which the shooter participates.

CLASSIFICATION

Shooters must present their PITA and ATA cards for correct assignment or classification.

Classification, for singles and doubles, will be based on the highest of either PITA or ATA current established averages for those shooters meeting the minimum target requirement.

Handicap yardage will be assigned according to current PITA rules.

96.00% and above	A
92.50% to 95.99%	B

Shooters who win or tie their class will be advanced to the next higher class for remaining events.

CLASSIFICATION EXCEPTIONS

16-Yard Classification

At State/Provincial and the Grand Pacific Championships Tournaments all sub-juniors, juniors, senior and elders who have not shot a minimum of 300 PITA registered 16-yard targets during the current and previous year combined shall be classified not less than Class "A". All others, including veterans and ladies must have 500 PITA registered 16-year targets during the same period of time, or must be classified not less than Class "A".

The class "A" penalty classification applies to tournaments utilizing five (5) or six (6) classes. If only four (4) classes are involved, then Class "B" would apply.

At State/Provincial shoots and at the Grand Pacific, at the discretion of the State/Provincial Board of Directors, or in the case of the Grand Pacific, the PITA Executive Committee, the requirement for the stated number of PITA registered targets may be satisfied by the substitution of a like number of registered ATA targets. The use of this waiver shall be clearly stated in the program. Shooters unable to present adequate records of ATA registered targets will be classified according to the regular PITA Rules identified above.

Doubles Classification

At State/Provincial and Grand Pacific Championship Tournaments all sub-juniors, juniors, seniors and elders who have not shot at

minimum of 100 PITA registered double targets during the current and previous year combined shall be classified not less than Class "B". All others, including veterans and ladies, must have 200 PITA registered double targets during the same period of time, or must be classified not less than Class "B".

The class "B" penalty classification applies to all tournaments utilizing four (4), five (5) and six (6) classes.

This requirement may be waived at State/Provincial shoots and the Grand Pacific, at the discretion of the State/Provincial Board of Directors, or in the case of the Grand Pacific, the PITA Executive Committee. The requirement for the stated number of PITA registered targets may be satisfied by the substitution of a like number of registered targets. The use of this waiver shall be clearly stated in the program. Shooters unable to present adequate records of ATA registered targets will be classified according to the regular PITA Rules identified above.

Handicap Classification

At State/Provincial and Grand Pacific Championship Tournaments, all shooters who have not shot at the below listed quantity of PITA registered handicap targets during the current and previous year combined shall be assigned yardage as follows:

Category	Quantity of PITA Targets	Minimum Assigned Penalty Yardage
Ladies	500	20 yards
Veterans	500	22 yards
Seniors	300	22 yards
Elders	300	22 yards
All Others	500	22 yards

At the discretion of the State/Provincial Board of Directors, or in the case of the Grand Pacific, the PITA Executive Committee, the requirement for the stated number of PITA registered handicap targets may be satisfied by the substitution of a like number of registered ATA handicap targets. The use of this waiver shall be clearly stated in the program. Shooters unable to present adequate records of ATA registered handicap targets will be classified according to the regular PITA Rules identified above.

SHOOTER RESPONSIBILITIES

→ Shooters are responsible for ensuring they are classified and handicapped properly as well as special classes identified. Errors at the classification desk do not relieve shooters of this responsibility.

→ Be ready when their squad is called. After two (2) minutes your squad will proceed without you.

→ Arrange for your shells ***IN ADVANCE*** of your arrival.

Placing advanced orders for your shells is recommended.

SHOOT MANAGEMENT RESPONSIBILITIES

→ Reserves the right to review and modify a shooter's classification at any time.

→ Reserves the right to change initial squadding assignments should it become necessary to minimize squad vacancies or adjust for earned yardage.

→ Provide orange White Flyer targets for this event.

→ Provide voice release systems to be used on all traps. No mechanical alternations shall be made to the equipment unless the equipment fails to present a legal target.

→ Provide a target setting committee that will set targets prior to each day's events. Target setting changes will be made during an event only if the targets become illegal. Any resetting of targets must be authorized and checked by a member of the target setting committee only. NO

EXCEPTIONS!

→ Assist shooters comply with Hawaii gun registration requirements.

→ Shoot management is responsible for target setting, however, repair and maintenance of the

traps is a Hawaii County Parks and Recreation responsibility. If it becomes necessary to shutdown a trap(s), shoot management reserves the right to change the format of the shoot to facilitate timely completion of shooting for the day. A change could result in competitors shooting more than 25 targets per trap in any given event.

→ All financial transactions will be in cash, check, or credit card in US currency. Pay-offs will be made by check in US funds and mailed to the participants after the shoot is finalized.

PURSES/OPTIONS

All purse and options entries are optional. Tie scores will divide the purse. No option money will be refunded or options purchased after the event has started. Unless otherwise noted, all 25s, 50s, and purse options will be paid out 60/40 high gun (ties split 50/50). 50 options will pay 3 combinations.

CROSS REGISTRATION

Targets thrown on February 17-20, 2022 may be cross registered with the ATA subject to all fees, rules, and requirements. ATA daily fee of \$3.00 and a HTA daily fee of \$4.00 will be charged to cross register targets.

SHOOT OFFS

Shoot offs for all tied scores will be conducted daily, as time allows. Failure to participate in a shoot off constitutes forfeiture. It is the shooter's responsibility to be aware of shoot-offs. No shoot offs will be conducted solely to determine a winner for purse or option money.
