

FALL CLASSIC GUIDELINES

Reviewed/Revised February 19, 2022

The Fall Classic is a telephonic shoot which may be hosted by multiple clubs in multiple states and province. The "zone" format is held during the last full weekend in September.

The Fall Classic is a major PITA shoot.

PROGRAMS

A Master Fall Classic Program will be created by the PITA and posted on the PITA website and social media.

Each club will be responsible for creating its own club-specific program to include fees, special events, additional options, and any other club information, and for promoting the shoot at their location. Club programs will be posted on the PITA website and social media.

FEES

Target fee to be set by each club for their site.

ADDITIONAL EVENTS

Individual clubs will have the option to host additional events as they can be fit into their program (i.e., a handicap event on Thursday).

TROPHIES

Fall Classic Trophies will be provided by the PITA for the program events (1-7).

Trophy winners will be entered into the trapshooters.com site as they are determined. Trophies will be mailed or delivered by the PITA per arrangements made with winners.

Clubs, at their expense, may offer additional trophies. If they choose to do so, information should be included in the club's program. <u>Make sure your club is charging appropriately to cover club expenses</u>.

High Over All Events 1-7 (800 Targets)	Champion Class AA, A, B, C & D Lady, Veteran, Senior, Elder, Junior & Sub-Junior
High All Around Events 4, 6 & 7	Champion Class AA, A, B, C & D

CASHIERING

The PITA will designate a lead cashier for the Fall Classic.

Cashiering will be provided and performed at each club, with all the scores uploaded to trapshooters.com (shootscoreboard.com) by the clubs' cashiers. To be a host club, <u>internet</u> access and the ability to print or display scores electronically will be necessary. Login instructions and website support numbers will be provided to each host club and cashier.

It is the responsibility of each site cashier and shoot management to wait for the final results (ties and winners) from the lead cashier and/or shoot scoreboard.com before announcing winners. Remember some sites are in different time zone so result reporting could take longer to be posted.

OPTIONAL FALL CLASSIC LEWIS

Optional Fall Classic Lewis will be offered on the championship singles, the championship doubles, and championship handicap events at \$10.00 per event; payout will be posted in the Fall Class Master Program. Optional Fall Classic Lewis will be calculated by trapshooters.com and/or lead cashier and submitted to PITA Secretary for payout. Individual shoot data will be submitted from each site to the PITA Secretary to compile and register scores as per a normal PITA shoot.

PITA added money will be included in the Fall Classic Master Program and announced by PITA on website and social media.

OTHER OPTIONS AND ADDED MONEY

Clubs may offer additional options and added money which will be calculated and paid at the individual club level. Magnums or other options "owned" by a state/provincial association will be available to the host clubs in those states based upon the decision(s) of those state/provincial associations.

SHOOT OFFS

Shoot offs will be recorded and noted via the combined scores posted on trapshooters.com site.

All ties in preliminary singles (event 1) and preliminary doubles (event 3) will be carried over. Both preliminary handicaps (events 2 and 5) will shoot off.

All championship events will be shot off.

CROSS-REGISTRATION

Cross-registration of PITA targets to the ATA will be available.

PROGRAM CHANGES

The PITA reserves the right to change or modify any portion of the Master Fall Classic Program.
