HANDICAPPING

PITA rules will govern this shoot. It is the shooter's responsibility to show both PITA and ATA average cards to determine handicap yardage assignment.

REGISTRATION AND CROSS-REGISTRATION
All targets in the program will be registered with the PITA. Targets may be cross-registered with the ATA, subject to all the fees, rules and requirements. The shooter must be a current member of the ATA and pay all appropriate ATA daily fees and target fees. Earned yardage will be awarded according to the rules of PITA and will apply directly to all cross-registered targets. Cards of both associations will be punched from the yardage shot.

RULES

By entering this competition, every shooter agrees to accept all official decisions and abide by PITA rules. It is the responsibility of each shooter to know the rules governing this competition. Copies of the current PITA rules are available at the handicap table.

REFUNDS

No entry fees, purses, or options will be refunded after an event has started

PAYOUT CHECKS

No payouts will be made during the shoot. The OSTA will mail all payout checks within 7 days of the end of the shoot.

CLASSIFICATION INFORMATION

PENALTY CLASSIFICATIONS:

SINGLES: At State/Provincial and the Grand Pacific Championships Tournaments all sub juniors, juniors, senior and elders who have not shot at a minimum of 300 PITA registered 16-yard targets during the current and previous year combined shall be classified not less than Class "A". All others, including veterans and ladies, must have 500 PITA registered 16-yard targets during the same period of time, or must be classified not less than Class "A".

DOUBLES: At State/Provincial and Grand Pacific Championship Tournaments all sub juniors, juniors, senior and elders who have not shot at a minimum of 100 PITA registered double targets during the current and previous year combined shall be classified not less than Class "B". All others, including veterans and ladies, must have 200 PITA registered double targets during the same period of time, or must be classified not less than Class "B".

HANDICAP: At State/Provincial and Grand Pacific Championship Tournaments, all shooters who have not shot at the below listed quantity of PITA registered handicap targets during the current and previous year combined shall be assigned yardage as follows:

| Category | Quantity of PITA Targets | Minimum Assigned Penalty Yardage |

| Sub-Juniors | 300 | 20 yards |
| Juniors | 300 | 22 yards |
| Ladies | 500 | 20 yards |

| Seniors | 300 | 22 yards |
| Elders | 300 | 22 yards |
| All Others | 500 | 22 yards |

The stated number of PITA registered targets may be satisfied by the substitution of a like number of registered ATA targets.
