The first registered shoot of the year brought a historic event. Kelsey Wickham became the youngest female shooter in PITA history to make the 27-yard line. Kelsey was 13 years and ten months old when she smashed her last target and won the handicap event at the PITA Doubles Marathon held at the Boise Gun Club on March 27th. She won with a score of 97 and also broke her first 50 straight in doubles (it was the only one broken all day out of over 300 chances).

March Multiplex.

34 Clubs – 381 Shooters – 50,800 Targets.

Brian Alquist shooting out of Boise was the star of the day as he fired 50 scores in both the singles and doubles events and won the Multiplex – wide HOA championship with 146 X 150. Bob Tomlin shooting out of Pocatello also broke 50 straight in the singles event.
