Doris Jean Fultz age 87, affectionately known as Jean, passed away at her home near Council, Idaho June 9, 2022, due to dementia. Jean was an award-winning outdoor photographer, avid horsewoman, golfer, champion water-skier, trap shooter, gold panner, rock collector, and hunted with her .270 in many states including Alaska. Jean was especially proud of her Delaware's of Idaho Indian heritage and being immortalized in the book LENAPE written by her cousin Charlotte Simmons. She was also proud to be the first woman journeyman carpenter in the state of Idaho while being employed by ASC Construction. She was a great lover of animals especially her dog Diesel, but her greatest joys in life came from spending time with her family. She especially enjoyed the moment she met her favorite actor, Jack Elam and obtained his autograph.
