Our Friend: Steve Young. 1951-2005.

It was a real shock to the Trapshooting community when Steve passed away suddenly in 2005. Not just because it was so unexpected, but because Steve had so many good friends and was so well liked and respected for his personality, friendship, accomplishments, and his efforts in support of gun clubs, state associations, and individuals within the sport. Steve loved sports and competing from when he was a young boy throughout his adult life. He loved playing softball, basketball, and bowling

Henrietta Young – 2007

Henrietta was born in Kuna and over the years she supported Steve and Don in their trapshooting “habit” and often traveled with them to shoots all over the West including several trips to the Grand Pacific. Her husband, children, grandchildren, and great- grandchildren were very important to her and they were the loves of her life. She loved and encouraged family get-togethers and activities.

Don Young. 1926 – 2012.

Don was truly an icon in Idaho trapshooting. His shooting accomplishments were many and his contributions to the sport were too numerous to list. He was a state champion, six-time All-Star team member, and in 2006 he was inducted into the Idaho Trapshooting Hall of Fame.

Don's list of wins was impressive, but his contributions to gun clubs and individuals were legendary. He was a life member of the Boise and Caldwell gun clubs and served as President at Boise. His support and help on many projects for these clubs over the years was vital to their success. Don often provided materials, money, labor and more if it was needed.

He also very quietly helped dozens of individuals become shooters in the sport he loved. Don especially liked to help young shooters get started or be able to continue to shoot and he never expected or wanted thanks from those he helped.

Steve, Henrietta, and Don – you might be gone but you are not forgotten. You were all a big part of the 50 years we are celebrating today.

Information on Program Purses and Options.

First of all – new shooters please understand that **you do not have to enter any of these purses or options to shoot the event.** They are a gamble and add excitement to the game. MAKE SURE YOU UNDERSTAND HOW THEY WORK. Also **please ask questions if you have them.** Very few shooters understood many of these things the first time they shot either. The Boise Gun Club wants you to have fun when you come and shoot with us. We don't want you entering something you don't understand. (You can ask Kent Harris, or Kay Klundt – shoot cashier, among others).

Since the Lewis option is the most popular option these days, there will be a handout at the handicap table to help you understand how it works.

Steve Young Jackpot Option.

For this shoot there will be no special event on the handicap. Instead, the Steve Young Jackpot Option is being offered as an alternative for the more “adventurous” handicap shooters. The option will cost \$25 with all of the money going back to the shooters on that day. It will be paid 1 in 6 entries, high gun.

6 entries or less will pay:	100% high gun
7-12 entries will pay:	60%-40% high gun
13-18 entries will pay:	50%-30%-20% high gun
19 or more will pay:	30%-20%-30%-20% high gun

(This last pay-off spreads the money out a little bit more)

Entry fee for this non-compulsory option is \$3 for each 50 (\$18) and the other \$2 of the \$20 entry will be added to the purse with the lowest total amount at the end of the shoot. Entry fees collected at this shoot will be added to the respective purses for the next Young family Memorial Shoot. Any two 25 straights win ONE-HALF of the respective purse. Each \$20 entry is eligible for one-half of any or all (i.e., 100 straight) of these perpetual purses. All ties divide respective monies.

Idaho Hall of Fame Lewis Purse.

Both the PITA and ATA Idaho state associations strongly support the Idaho Trapshooting Hall of Fame. The Hall of Fame purses will be Lewis Class purses on the handicap events. They will cost \$15 and will be paid: one pay per 6 entries with \$10 to the shooters and \$5 donated to the Hall of Fame to help support and preserve the history of Idaho trapshooting.

Program General Information.

Cross Registration with the ATA is Available at this Shoot! Ask at the Handicap Table.

Sign Up, Registration and Classification – Will start at 8 A.M. with shooting to start at 9:30. You will notice that we are having an extra-long registration time. This should make it so that shooters won't have to wait in line very long and we can start the shooting on time. **This will only work**

if shooters don't wait until the last minute to sign up. Make it easy on yourself (and the cashier) and get there early to sign up

Shells – May not be available. Legal reloads are permitted. **Please catch your shells and deposit them in the trash cans if you don't save them.**

Awards – No shooter may win more than one award per event. You must notify the handicapper if you are shooting Lady, Vet, Junior or Rookie classifications. No minimum number of shooters required for awards.

Shoot-offs – All ties for awards will be shot off, be available or forfeit. All ties on option money will be split.

Kitchen – Will be open for this shoot. Food is available.

Conduct and Program Changes – The Boise Gun Club reserves the right to refuse entry or withdraw any contestant who in any way interferes with the safety, harmony, and enjoyment of this shoot. The Boise Gun Club also reserves the right to change or alter any portion of this program at any time prior to, or during, this shoot.

Practice Trap – One practice trap will be open an hour before and during the shoot. Purchase practice tickets at the B.G.C. cashier's window at member prices.

Special Category Information – Vet-65 or older. Junior-under 18. Rookie- You may shoot as a rookie shooter for one year from the first time you join either the PITA or the ATA. It is the shooter's responsibility to know when you are no longer eligible.

Idaho PITA All-Star Team Points – There will be a maximum of 27 team points available at this shoot.

Straight Pins – First time Idaho PITA 25-50-75 straight pins will be available to all shooters compliments of the State association. PITA 100 straight and 27 yard pins to those who qualify compliments of the parent PITA.

New Shooters – Less than 500 registered singles – shoot B class. Less than 200 registered doubles – shoot B class.

Win a Boise Gun Club Yardstick – Anyone who earns a punch in the handicap will win a B.G.C. Yardstick.

50 YEARS FOR THE EAST KUNA-MORA ROAD LOCATION

As we honor the memory of the Young family we also want to celebrate the 50th Anniversary of the Boise Gun Club at its present location. The club has been shooting since at least 1898 and in that time it has been located in several different spots – including where the BSU Campus is now located and the previous location which was just under the rim off Federal Way.

We completed building this club in 1972 and had our “Grand Opening” shoot September 9-10. 104 total shooters attended. (Four of them are still shooting registered targets today – can you guess who they are?). We will have a display from that shoot – the program (target prices – wow!), the shoot results, pictures of the shooters who fired the first shot and broke the first 100 straight and more.

We will also have displays of various shooters, events, changes and improvements over the 50 year period – such as the largest state shoot in Idaho history where we had 421 shooters in one event.

This celebration honors all the shooters from the past and thanks all the present-day shooters who continue to support the club and its activities.
