Details: (changes for 2023 in bold)

- You will start with your 2022 year-end average or your current average, whichever is greater at the time of your first event. There are five classes: AA, A, B, C, & D
- The minimum targets required to qualify for the trophies is 1000. Each event offers up to 500 targets, contact club for number of targets offered. Shoot more than your minimum as your best 10 scores will be used.
- Clubs may offer the ODC any day upon approval of the shoot application (must be filed with OSTA Secretary more than 48 hours in advance and can not conflict with already scheduled weekend event). ODC may follow Multiplex if club so requests on shoot application.
- Cross-registration will be available at those clubs who offer it.

Traps:

• Its is STRONGLY recommended that clubs either allow shooters to draw their trap, or stick to a rotation.

Money:

- Targets fees will be set by each club. Other fees: PITA fee: \$4/day, OSTA fee-\$2/100, Trophies/\$50 draws-\$4/100, Cashier-\$2/day. All trophy money will be returned to the shooters at the finale as either trophy or drawings.
- At each shoot, there will be a \$ 50 random draw. There must be at least 2500 targets thrown before a winner is drawn. A second winner will be drawn after 5000 targets have been thrown.

Trophies:

• Champion, winner and r/u of each class (AA-A-B-C-D), high Elder, Senior, Veteran, Lady, Junior.

Awards:

- Trophies will be awarded at the annual meeting during the State Shoot.
- Cash and/or raffle prizes-depending on season participation. One ticket for each shooter for each event shot throughout the ODC season. Must be present to win.



Opportunity for clubs to host a PITA-wide doubles marathon
This is not a mandatory event for clubs
500 Doubles Targets offered

PDC can be a stand-alone event or it may be offered in conjunction with an existing state/provincial doubles marathon

Target Fees set by the club

PITA rules governing doubles will be followed

For PDC events ONLY – Shooter classification will be established at 1st PDC entered and will not change for PDC events

ATA Cross-Registration may be available. Check Club's program for details

To qualify for PDC Finale Awards, shooter must shoot minimum of 1500 PDC doubles

Exception: Jrs & Sub-Jrs must shoot minimum 1000 PDC Doubles

PDC Cashier will be Bob McLendon

PDC Finale will be held at the 2023 Grand Pacific (day before the Grand – July 22nd)
