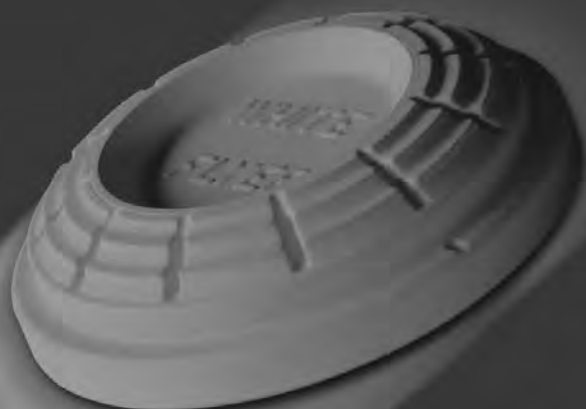

REMINDER • REMINDER

NOTICE

These rules will be in effect and enforced at the Washington State Shoot as stated in the proper sections of the A.T.A. Rule Book.

RULE III

H. SAFETY

(1. - 7.)

8. Alcohol and drugs impair judgement and the A.T.A rules pertaining to alcohol and/or drugs must be enforced by club management. This rule shall be strictly complied with and shall apply to practice shooting as well as regular events. (Rule III, U., 2., a.)

(9. - 15.)

16. ALL persons including competitors, referees, and trap personnel, must wear eye and hearing protection while on the trap field. Failure to comply may result in disqualification.
The management may disqualify a contestant for violations of these rules.

U. DISQUALIFICATION

2. IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY AND THE REQUIRED DUTY of shoot management to immediately remove and disqualify any contestant at any time during an A.T.A. sanctioned tournament:
 - a. who is under the influence of any drug or alcoholic beverage or who consumes any alcoholic beverage or drugs during participation in any event, sub-event, or between events or sub-events including shoot offs and practice, or
 - b. or drugs before starting or during any event, sub-event, shootoff, or practice, or
 - c. who handles a gun dangerously on or off the firing line, or
 - d. who diliberately or carelessly violates gun safety precautions, Official Rules regarding Safety (Rule III H), or in any manner endangers contestants, and spectators.

Shooter's class for HOA and HAA is determined by the class on the opening day of the shoot.

SPECIAL NOTICE: The Annual State Association Meeting will be held Saturday between Events 7 & 8.

The Gun Club will open Wednesday at 10:00 AM for practice and the Handicap table will open at 3:00 PM-6:00 PM for Handicapping and Squadding.

ELECTION INFORMATION

This year the membership will be electing 5 directors for a 3 year term. One member as Delegate, and two Alternate Delegates whose terms are 1 year. We will also be electing two Junior Ambassadors. One from the ranks of the Junior Shooters, and one from the ranks of Sub-Juniors.

Anyone wishing to be a candidate for Director must register with the Secretary by 6:00 p.m. Friday Evening, or sign up in person at the handicap table.

The approved candidate list will be posted at the handicap table Saturday morning by 8:00 a.m., where ballots will be available. The ballot box will remain open until 5:00 p.m. Saturday, at which time balloting will cease and the Election Committee will tabulate the ballots and post the results on the scoreboard before noon Sunday.

Please Note: Voter's name will not appear on the ballot, only your ATA number will be imprinted to prove residency and eliminate duplication. Shooters without plastic cards can vote if they contact the election committee to validate their ballot.

Please Respond: Good thinkers and workers are always needed on the Board of Directors.

Willfull tampering with this election process could result in shoot disqualification.

This is an invitational tournament and the management reserves the authority to reject, refund or disqualify any contestant who, in its judgement, interferes with the conduct, accuracy or sportsmanship of the shoot. Likewise, the management may exercise the right to change or modify this program in whole or in part.

NO UNAUTHORIZED SETTING OF TRAPS!

**No soliciting on club grounds without a permit.
VIOLATORS MAY BE EXPELLED.**

Watch your score - it cannot be changed after leaving the shooting post. Your score will be called at the end of each five targets.

All purse, options, and special event purses will be paid with one check on completion of the shoot. All checks over \$600 will not be issued without a W-9.

All persons who enter this shoot will receive a copy of the payoff sheet for all four days (Adopted by W.S.T.A. 6/71)

All amateur shooters including Non-Residents are eligible for event purses unless otherwise posted in the program.

SHOOT OFFS

All ties will be shot off.

The first call will be announced 15 MINUTES after the last squad when the last daily event has finished shooting. The second call will be five minutes later. Any shooter who does not report to his assigned trap within three minutes after the second call will be disqualified.

ATA RULES

J. SPECIAL CATEGORIES

All Ladies, Sub-Juniors, Junior, Junior Gold, Veterans, and Senior-Vets must declare their special category at the time of classification in any registered tournament if they wish to compete as a category shooter. Without such declaration, the contestant will not be allowed to compete for the applicable category trophy. No contestant will be allowed to declare or change a special declaration after firing his/her first shot. The only exception to this rule will be to correct an ATA classification error. The following rules apply to shooters who have declared a special category. At all tournaments where All American points will be awarded in any event, shooters may declare only one (1) category (i.e. Lady I, Lady II, Sub-Junior, Junior, Junior Gold, Sub Veteran, or Senior Veteran) Note: Chair shooters are exempt from this rule.

- 1. A female shooter, who has not reached her 55th birthday, may declare Lady I.**
- 2. A female shooter, who has reached her 55th birthday, may declare Lady II.**
- 3. A shooter who has not reached his/her 15th birthday may declare Sub-Junior.**
- 4. A shooter who is 15 but has not reached his/her 18th birthday may declare as Junior.**
- 5. A shooter who is 18 but has not reached his/her 23rd birthday may declare as Junior Gold.**
- 6. A shooter who is 55 but not reached his/her 65th birthday may declare as a Sub Veteran.**
- 7. A shooter who is 65 but not reached his/her 70th birthday may declare as a Veteran.**
- 8. A shooter who is 70 years of age and older may declare as Senior Veteran.**

This rule does not supercede paragraph 10

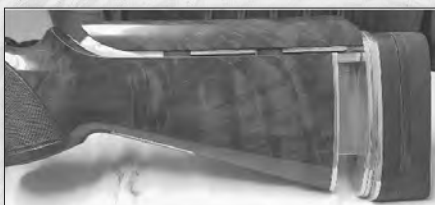
9. Age based categories are established on the birthday of the shooter. For purposes of determining age category for HOA and HAA awards the category declared by the participant on the first day he/she shoots shall be used.
10. Shooters who become eligible for new age based categories during the target year may elect to continue to compete in the previous category for the remainder of that target year. (For example, a shooter reaching age 70 may elect to continue to shoot as a Veteran for the remainder of the current target year.) However, once a shooter has elected to move to the new category that decision is irrevocable and he/she may not again declare eligibility for the previous category. Junior shooters reaching the age of 18 may continue to declare Junior category for the remainder of the current target year.
