As many of you know, this has been a year of uncertainty for the WSPITA. However, because of you, our shooters, donors, advertisers and sponsors, we are in a much better financial position. Due to lower attendance on Wednesday, we have removed that day as part of the state program and have added instead the Washington doubles league and PITA doubles challenge on that day.

When you look at our program this year, you will see that the target prices have risen more than normal. The cost of targets and the cost of labor for scorekeepers and trap loaders has risen considerably, which has forced the Board to raise target prices to assure enough return to keep putting on the state shoot in the future. Unfortunately, the past several years of the state shoot have consisted of massive losses for the WSPITA, significant changes must be made to continue having the PITA in Washington State. It's not about making money, we are just striving to break even, and hopefully put a little away for next year's State Shoot.

Please plan to attend the General Meeting on Friday the 14th at 8 AM. If you have any questions or concerns, please let us know. We will have our shooter appreciation dinner on Saturday at 5 pm. It will consist of a spaghetti dinner with a dessert potluck. On Saturday we will have our awards ceremony at 7 pm, honoring the winners, awarding silent auction items, high average team awards, and milestones. We will also raffle prizes for our youth program.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Advance Squadding available through: *PreSquad.com* (page 19). Presquadding will open on **May 10, 2023** and go through **July 7th, 2023**. Entry fees will be in U.S. currency, American check or Canadian check in U.S. funds (NSF fee \$35.00). A \$5 pre-squadding fee will be paid at registration at the shoot. Shooters requesting squad changes after the shoot begins will pay a \$10.00 change fee.

Refunds – No entry fees, purses or options, will be refunded after an event has started.

<u>Payoffs</u> – **All** payoffs will be paid by check and mailed to shooters after this shoot ends. Check event payoff sheets prior to the start of the last event for any questions.

IRS REGULATIONS – Before checks over \$599.00 can be distributed, the IRS requires form W-9 to be completed. Please furnish this information to the cashier or the WSPITA Treasurer.

Three Minute Call – Be ready to shoot when your squad is called. The squad will be held no more than 3 minutes, after which time you will need to re-squad, subject to a \$10.00 fee.

Re-squadding will be on the same bank as the original, if possible. Ten (10)minutes will be allowed for gun breakdown.

No shooter will be called on the loud speaker. **STRICTLY ENFORCED!**<u>Short Squads</u> – Short squads will be avoided when possible. <u>A referee</u> will accompany one and two person squads.

<u>Target Setting</u> – Targets will be set by the **Target Setting Team** each day according to PITA rules.

Targets will be reset ONLY if the setting changes present a significant variation. All resetting of targets must be done by authorized personnel.

<u>Ties</u> – All ties in preliminary events will be decided by a shoot off, unless all parties decide to carry over. All Championship events will be decided by a shoot off.

Shoot Offs – One call ONLY. Contestant must be available at the shoot off table within five minutes after being called for shoot off or will forfeit all rights herein. Look for posting on bulletin board. Any SUB-JUNIOR (SJ), JUNIOR (JR), LADY (LD), VETERAN (VT), SENIOR (SR), ELDER (EL) shooter must declare for which trophy they wish to compete for prior to entering into a shoot-off. One trophy ONLY may be won.

<u>Special Categories</u> – Prior to shooting each event, if you qualify in any special category, i.e. Sub-Junior (under 15), Junior (15-17), Lady, Veteran (65-69), Senior (70-74), or Elder (75 and older) please check your handicap sheet and score sheets to make certain your name shows the proper symbol for eligibility. Failure to do so within 10 min after the last score is posted will disqualify you from options AND trophies. Must be two or more shooters in a category for a trophy to be awarded.

Handicapping – PITA rules govern. It's the shooter's responsibility to show both PITA & ATA average cards to determine handicap yardage assignments. Your PITA card must be complete with all scores entered through the last shoot you attended, with averages computed on the last 1000 Singles and Doubles. Personnel at the handicap table will assist you if necessary. A shooter who is an ATA member, and is joining the PITA for the first time will be assigned yardage equal to their ATA yardage. If a shooter has assigned yardage in both the ATA and the PITA, the greater yardage will be assigned. At State/Provincial and Grand Pacific Championship tournaments, all shooters who have NOT shot at the listed quantity of PITA registered Singles and Handicap targets during the current and previous year combined, shall be assigned penalty class and/or yardage as follows. Please refer to page 8.

Minimum of 200 targets -or- assigned Class B (VT, LD, All Others)

<u>Membership</u> – All participants in the program must be a current member of the PITA.

<u>Guns and Loads</u> - All contestants shall follow the PITA established rules <u>regarding guns and loads found on pages 15-17 of the PITA RULE BOOK.</u>

<u>Earned Yardage</u> – If you earn yardage during the shoot, you must check with the office. It may be necessary to re-squad you.

Class Winners and Ties will NOT be advanced to next class on all events.

<u>Please read your program and current Rules Book.</u>

KNOW THE RULES...do not put all the responsibility on the referee when you are shooting!

<u>Chair Classification</u> – An eligible shooter in the Chair Classification shall be a shooter who is physically disabled and due to such physical disability is required to be seated in a cart or wheelchair while shooting.

<u>Shooter Responsibility</u> – A shooter must shoot in the proper class and at the correct yardage. An error at the handicap table does <u>not</u> excuse any shooter from this responsibility of knowing the rules.

<u>Disqualification and Suspension</u> - Per page 23 of the PITA RULE BOOK; 'Officials of the State/Provincial Associations are authorized to disqualify and recommend for suspension, any contestant violating current PITA rules or whose conduct, <u>in their judgment</u>, is <u>unsafe</u>, <u>unsportsmanlike</u>, <u>or disruptive</u> to the harmony of any registered tournament..."

All shooters shall keep their squads moving at a continuous pace. There shall be NO 'playing through'. Shoot management **only** shall determine any special issue delays in shooting.

<u>Errors in Scores</u> – Scores must be contested and settled before the shooter starts shooting on the next post, otherwise the score must stand.

<u>Pets</u> "must" be kept on a leash. Please don't allow them to forage on deceased critters, and remember to pick up after them... no land mines!

This is to certify that the Evergreen Sportsmen's Club has been authorized to hold a registered shoot at Littlerock, WA on July 13, 14, 15, and 16, 2023. The Pacific International Trapshooting Association rules will govern all events and scores will be included in the official record.



<u>Cross-Registration</u> – Targets may be cross-registered with the ATA, subject to all the fees, rules, and requirements. The shooter must be a current member of the ATA and pay appropriate ATA daily fees and target fees. Earned yardage will be awarded according to the rules of the PITA and will apply directly to all cross-registered targets. Cards of <u>BOTH</u> associations will be punched from the yardage shot.

Orange 3/4 New York Style pitch targets will be utilized for all registered events and shoot offs.

<u>Rules</u> - By entering the competition, <u>every</u> shooter agrees to accept all official decisions and abide by the PITA rules. Members are strongly encouraged to know the rules and abide by them, both for their own benefit and for the benefit of the other shooters.

Registration – All targets in the program will be registered with the PITA.

Rookie Of The Year – Any Washington state shooter who has not registered any targets in any association until after the 2022 WSPITA State Shoot is eligible to compete for this award. The winning state Rookie will represent Washington State at the 2023 PITA Grand Pacific. Awarded on the Singles (Events 6 & 8) and Handicap (Event 9) State Championship events.

(A Sub-Junior is a person who has not attained their 15th birthday. A Junior is person who has not attained their 18th birthday.)

<u>Champion of Champions -</u> Open to the Champion and Lady Champion of the 2023 WA Singles Championship events. Should the winner not be in attendance at the 2023 Pacific Grand, the next highest scoring contestant may compete for Champion of Champions. This event is run by the Exec. Committee of the PITA at the Pacific Grand.

<u>Champion of Champions & Rookie Competitions at the Grand Pacific</u> – Should the State/Provincial Champion or Runner up be absent from the Grand the person with the next highest score, in attendance, may represent that State/Province in the competition.

Entries must be posted on the sheet provided on the bulletin board prior to 9:00 am Saturday, July 15th, 2023.



If you earn Class or Yardage added money, you are not eligible for Special Category added money. Just like a trophy, if you win Runner Up, you are not eligible for Veteran, Etc.

CLUB TEAM COMPETITION

All Washington State club team members must be posted on the sheet provided on the bulletin board prior to 9:00 a.m., Saturday, July 15th, 2023. One Washington State "at-large" team will be allowed. Club team members must be current members of their respective PITA clubs, prior to the 2023 State Shoot. The club must have thrown PITA targets. The "At-Large" team is set aside for PITA members who shoot PITA targets but live in areas where there are no clubs throwing PITA targets, such as South Eastern Washington and North Eastern Washington. If two or more shooters sign up for the "at large" team in any class the WSPITA Board of Directors will draw lots to resolve the final "at large" team.

Each four shooter team will be comprised of one shooter from each class AA, A, B, C, or D. A shooter in a lower class may substitute for a higher class shooter. Example: a "B" shooter can fill the "A" or "AA" billet. Washington State clubs may enter as many teams as they can man. A shooter may only be on one team.

Washington State Singles Magnum Option

Purse Cost: \$12 Current Total Purse: \$1,291.80 plus day's entries

Shooters are eligible for 25% of the purse per event. It will be split between all shooters who qualify. To qualify, a shooter must break a qualifying score within their class. These scores are as follows:

AA: 100

A: 100

B: 99

C: 98

D: 97

EXAMPLE: Bob in AA Class breaks a 100 and Jim in D Class breaks a 98. Both shooters broke a qualifying score and are entitled to a quarter of the pot plus 1/2 of the daily entries split between them.

Washington State Shoot Handicap Magnum Options

Purse Cost: \$12 Current Total Purse: \$2,767.28 plus day's entries

Functions like normal magnum option except that it applies for only the Washington State shoot. Purse for each trap is as follows (50% payout, all ties divide. Purse may vary by shoot date.)

1&2: \$1,311.67

1&3: \$553.38

3&4: \$706.86

Bremerton Gold Mountain Handicap Option

Cost: \$3 Current Total Purse: \$1,188 plus day's entries

Shooters qualify by breaking 100 straight in Handicap event. The winners are awarded 90% of the purse (all ties divide).

Big Dog Handicap Option

Cost \$25 Purse: The day's entries. The top score in the Handicap event that played the option will receive 100% of the purse (all ties divide).

Handicap Cash Purse

Purse Cost: \$10 Cash Purse divided High Gun System on Total 100. One pay for each 5 entries, by yardage. 3 Yardage groups (19-22.5; 23-25.5; 26-27)

Singles Cash Purse


