CONTESTANT QUALIFICATION INFORMATION FOR CALIFORNIA PITA SERIES AWARDS

All contestants must be PITA members in good standing with current dues paid. The shooter does not have to be a resident of California. Any "Series" targets shot without a current PITA membership will be deleted from the Series competition.

The contestant's status will be determined at the first "Series" shoot that he/she participates in. Such status includes beginning yard, current address and date of birth on file with the CSTA Series Committee verified from PITA membership information.

The contestant's status consists of his/her yardage (19-20, 21-22, 23-24, 25-26 and 27) and special category, if any, (Lady, Veteran, Senior, Elder, Junior, Sub-Junior). The contestant's yardage at the first "Series" shoot will establish his/her yardage group and will remain the same for trophy purposes regardless of yardage increases or decreases. Special category status will also be established at the first "Series" shoot and will remain the same for trophy purposes regardless of category change due to age.

In order to compete for a YARDAGE GROUP TROPHY, all yardage groups will shoot at 1500 targets regardless of special category (500 16-yard, 500 handicap, 500 doubles). To compete for a SPECIAL CATEGORY TROPHY, contestant must shoot at 500 16-yard targets and 500 handicap targets. Contestants may shoot as many more targets as desired. The CSTA Series Committee will only use 100 target events to determine highest 500 targets in each discipline. Special category contestants may also compete for yardage awards on the basis of 1500 targets but only one trophy may be won.

Yardage award ties will be shot off at the "Series Award Shoot" based on 20 16-yard, 20 handicap and 20 (10 pair) doubles targets. Special category shoot-offs will consist of 25 16-yard and 25 handicap targets.

The Series Award Shoot is held the first weekend in November of each year at rotating clubs. Complete rules available at all clubs.
