

TARGET SETTING

Traps will be set each morning. Target setting will be changed during the event only if they have been determined to be throwing illegal targets. Traps will only be changed by club official or their designated representative.

SHOOT OFFS

All shoot offs will be held immediately after the last registered event of the day. Ties for trophies will be shot off unless all shooters agree to another method. Voice release systems will be used on all events including shoot offs.

AWARDS

No shooter is eligible for more than one prize per event. Class winners & ties move up for Event 4.

There must be two or more entries in a Class, Yardage Group or Sub-Category for a prize to be awarded.

Earned yardage will be awarded according to the rules of the HOST ASSOCIATION OF THIS SHOOT (PITA).
