WHAT IS LMFV?



Have you been practicing trap for a while and are looking for a new challenge? Or are you completely new to the sport and are looking to improve your skills?

If the answer is yes, then the Lower Mainland/ Fraser Valley (LMFV) Trap League is for you. Experience the fun of competitive style trapshooting in a friendly setting and meet other shooters from the trapshooting community.

In 2021, the five Lower Mainland/Fraser Valley (LMFV) gun clubs started a Winter Trap League to introduce the sport of trapshooting to new shooters and offer competition to seasoned shooters during the off-season. The Winter League was consistently attended by 50+ shooters, most of whom were new to competitive trapshooting.

For 2023, the LMFV League is introducing a Summer League that will run from May to September with one league shoot per month.

Shooting a LMFV League event is like shooting practice rounds but your scores get registered and you have a chance to win trophies, raffle prizes, and money. We have a group of volunteers who will help you through registration and get you familiarized with the league format. All you have to do is bring your shotgun and shells.

There are 3 events at every league shoot:

- **Singles** - This is your regular 16 yard trap;
- **Handicap** - This is similar to singles but shot from further back; and
- **Doubles** - This is shot from the 16 yard line but two targets are thrown at the same time.

Each event consists of 50 targets so you will need 2 boxes of shells for each event you shoot. You don't have to register for all three events but we highly recommend that you do as they are a lot of fun.
