This issue of OT2 will cover the winners and results of the Claiborne Memorial shoot at Twin Falls held June 3-4, the Silver Shoot at Pocatello on June 10-11, the June Multiplex, and the highlight of most shooter's year – the Idaho State shoot held June 23-25 at the Caldwell Gun Club.

Dave Claiborne Memorial Shoot. June 3-4. Twin Falls.

Predictions were for rain, but 47 shooters instead got two days of nice shooting weather and registered 19,600 targets.

Jeff Wright followed up his 199 to win the ATA state singles championship the weekend before with another 199 to take the singles championship. He also was high in the Saturday handicap with 97, had an almost perfect 99 to win the doubles and took the HOA champion's pin by 7 birds with his 577 score.

Stubby Hughes, visiting from Alaska, was high in the Preliminary handicap with 98 and Clay Brown topped Kyle Perry in a shoot-off after their 95's led scoring in the handicap championship.

Wright and George Stevens fired the only perfect scores of the shoot with 100's on Sunday.

Mike Houser continued his red hot shooting as he won the 200 bird doubles event with 197, the 200 bird singles event with a perfect 200, had the high score in the first handicap with 98 and

took the HOA champion's pin with his 680 score.

Idaho PITA State Shoot. Caldwell Gun Club. June 23-25, 2023.

145 shooters from Idaho, Washington, Alaska, California, Nevada, British Columbia, and Utah took advantage of what you always wish for – a perfect weather weekend for the Idaho State shoot. They shot at 80,500 registered targets along with a buddy-backer event on Friday.

Leonard Wehking added another state championship to his previous singles crown, as he won a three-way shoot-off with Kelly Wickham and Tammy Shuyler after they had tied for the handicap championship with scores of 96.

Kyle Perry won the singles championship in a one round shoot-off of 199's over Kevin Miles and Stuart Welton. He also defeated Welton in a shoot-off for the HAA championship after they tied with 387. Welton won the J.O. Cotant Preliminary handicap with his 97, was state R-U in the doubles championship, and was the HOA champion with a score of 771.

Russell Pierce won his first Idaho Championship since moving to Idaho as he fired a near perfect 99 in the Doubles championship. (He missed his first bird).

On Friday's Preliminary events Rick Erickson had the only 100 in the Rex Kiser Memorial Singles, Patrick Pemelton from Nevada had the lone 99 in the Dell Hartley Memorial Handicap and Jason Nelson also from Nevada topped the Nick Adams Memorial Doubles with his 99. Nelson also had the only 200 in the Championship singles and was non-resident HOA champ with a 760 score.
