For each round of Doubles targets shot (including Event #3 Doubles), you will receive a raffle ticket for a gun. At Redding's last shoot of the year, October 14, 2023, 1 ticket will be drawn and those shooters who have shot at least 1000 targets are eligible for their choice of any gun. The remaining 6 guns are open to all doubles shooters. (1 gun per shooter). **MUST BE PRESENT TO WIN.**

- You may shoot Event #3 Doubles on Friday as long as you are shooting Event 1 or 2 on Saturday.
- If you shoot Event #3 Doubles on Friday, your last score of the day will be used for Event #3 (YOU MUST DECLARE LAST ROUND FOR EVENT #3, and indicate "L" for Lewis if you plan to enter that option, PRIOR TO SHOOTING IT).
- You CANNOT shoot any more doubles on Friday, once declared. You CANNOT shoot Event #3 on Saturday if you declared on Friday. If you plan to shoot Doubles on Saturday, DO NOT DECLARE on Friday.
