Nestled against one of the most picturesque backdrops in the state, our club offers a great setting for this tournament. With our high desert targets and top-quality White Flyer pitch targets, coupled with BRB wired voice call systems on all tournament traps, we are committed to providing a professional and unforgettable shooting experience.

For those new to our facility, we'll be operating 10 program traps, with an additional trap #11 available for practice sessions. Some seasoned shooters have compared this year's program, with 200 targets a day and hot loaders, to the Grand Pacific of the past with 500 shooters and we look forward to making this challenge a success.

Prepare your taste buds for culinary delights from Yep's Kitchen! Indulge in delectable breakfast and lunch offerings served from 7 am through mid-afternoon during the event. Stay tuned for tantalizing menu details! Ice will be available for purchase, and we're in the process of arranging a special vendor for Calcutta night.

To ensure your comfort throughout your stay, our clubhouse facility with showers will be open to all campers, complemented by conveniently located porta-potties and handwash stations across the property. If you're bringing or renting a golf cart or ATV, ensure you have suitable liability insurance, and please remember these vehicles are not permitted on our paved walk paths behind traps or in front of the clubhouse. For the comfort and safety of all attendees, kindly keep dogs on a leash and clean up after them.

A map will be distributed to streamline the check-in process, and our board members are available for any inquiries. For the latest updates, visit our website or join our RV/Shooters email list for timely communication. Take a look at our event page (page 71) for other shoots we will be hosting this year.

Our heartfelt gratitude goes out to our volunteers, whose dedication makes this event possible. To all participants, best of luck, and may your shooting be on target!

Attention RV guests! As we transition into summer, it's essential to be prepared for increased demand on our facilities. While we believe our club can handle the influx, we ask all RVers to come equipped for any potential challenges.

On the water side we ask that everyone please fill your RV water tanks prior to arrival to help conserve our water supply. In the event of high demand, we may need to implement an alternate water schedule.

Additionally, ensure your RV is stocked with ample LP to run appliances and hot water heaters. Note that our 20-amp hookups won't support running AC units; if you require full cooling capacity, consider bringing a backup generator. For those using 50/30 amp services, please limit AC usage to one unit. Your cooperation ensures everyone has a comfortable and enjoyable stay.

RULES AND INFORMATION

This tournament will be governed by current PITA rules. All shooters agree to accept official decisions and abide by PITA rules. All contestants must be current PITA members. Annual PITA membership is \$25 for renewals (online card), \$30 for wallet size card. 1st-time members, who join the PITA at a major shoot, will receive a free membership.

PROGRAM CHANGES: The PITA reserves the right to change this program in whole or in part as may become necessary. All changes will be posted at the cashier windows.

CROSS REGISTRATION WITH ATA: ATA daily fee of \$4.00, OSATA target fee of \$2.00/100 and cashier processing fee of \$2.00/day will be charged.

CASHIER'S HOURS: The cashier's office will be open every day, beginning Thursday, July 18 at 8:00 am.

PAYMENT OF FEES: VISA/MC accepted for entry fees and options only with a 3% maintenance fee. ALL RETURNED CHECKS ARE SUBJECT TO A \$25 CHARGE. Canadian checks accepted if US FUNDS is printed on the check by your bank. Handwritten 'US funds' checks are no longer accepted at our bank. <u>Canadian currency will not be accepted.</u>

CLASSIFICATION: Your PITA average card will be <u>printed at registration</u> and attached to your entry form. <u>If scores are missing from the card, it is your responsibility to notify member services before shooting your 1st <u>event</u>. Shooters must provide current cards from any other organized trapshooting organization in which they participate.</u>

Any member of the Governance Committee, Directors or Officers of any State/Provincial Association, while serving an elected term of office or members of the Executive Committee may after proper investigation, review of a shooter's records of scores of <u>any trapshooting</u> <u>competition and documentation</u> increase a shooter's handicap yardage assignment according to the shooter's established ability. Honorary directors and gun club officers are specifically excluded from this authority. This increase shall become the shooter's handicap yardage assignment and his/her averages card, or temporary receipt punched accordingly, subject to the appeal process. A shooter who accepts the increased yardage assignment at the immediate shoot will not prejudice their right of protest. Established ability may be determined from official registered averages, non-registered scores, or a combination thereof.

Contestants must shoot their longest yardage of any organization or league with official records, in which they participate.

ATA targets may be substituted for PITA targets to meet minimum requirements. Refer to current Rulebook for minimum requirements to avoid penalty classification.

AGE DIVISIONS-SPECIAL CATEGORIES: Category changes occur on your actual birthday except when it occurs during a registered shoot. Your age category for the first event you shoot remains the same for all Grand Pacific events. Categories are as follows:

(SJ) Sub-Junior: up to and including the age of 14 (JR) Junior: 15-17, (VT) Veteran: age 65 to the age of 69, (SR) Senior: age 70 to the age of 74, (EL) Elder: age 75 or older, (CH) "Defined as being seated on a manually operated or electric wheelchair or cart when shooting."

It is the responsibility of all special category shooters to assure they are so indicated on their entry receipt and the posted scoreboard. Please notify the cashier's office, prior to event completion, if the appropriate symbols are not shown on the posted bulletin sheet at the scoreboard: LD, CH, VT, SR, EL, JR, SJ. Only one special category may be chosen.

AN ERROR AT CLASSIFICATION TABLE DOES NOT RELIEVE A SHOOTER OF THE RESPONSIBILITY OF A CORRECT CLASSIFICATION, YARDAGE ASSIGNMENT, OR CATEGORY ASSIGNMENT.

In a championship event (Events 9, 11, 13, or 14) shoot-off participants for Champion or Runner-up must declare, before the shoot off begins, which trophy they wish to fall back to if they lose the shoot off (class, yardage group or special category). Only one trophy per event may be won, except for Y-E-S awards.

SQUADDING: Contestants may pre-squad online at www.presquad.com through July 17th. A \$5.00/shooter pre-squad fee is required by either method. Remember, PRE-SQUADDING IS A PRIVILEGE. If you make a reservation for yourself and friends and find one cannot attend or earns yardage, please cancel and correct your reservation.

Shooters on squads with fewer than three shooters will be re-squadded to fill squads. Please check presquad.com prior to July 17th and if your squad does not have three shooters, re-squad or the cashier will do it for you.

No variation in assigned squad number allowed unless authorized by the cashiers. If you are assigned an early squad for the first event you enter, you will be assigned an early squad for all remaining events of the tournament.

If you have not registered at the cashier window before the first event for which you pre-squadded, you will lose your position for the remainder of the pre-squadded events. Shooter requested squad changes require a \$10.00 change fee. You will be assigned to the same bank of traps as your original squad. If you have questions about this, please speak with shoot management. When necessary (i.e., machine malfunction, uneven bank rotations or other problems) squads may be moved to open banks to facilitate event completion.

OPTION MONEY: No entry fees or option money will be refunded after the event starts. IRS rules require a social security number before winnings of \$600 or more may be distributed (includes all winnings from PITA during the calendar year- Grand Pacific, Fall Classic and Multiplex). Please complete a W-9 at the cashier's office if you reach this amount.

EARNED YARDAGE: Should earned yardage cause more than the allowable yardage variation within the squad the shooter earning yardage will be assigned to the nearest compatible squad.

TRAPS & TARGETS: All squads will be shot in banks of two traps (50 targets to a trap). When necessary, shoot management may move squads to equalize event completion. The PA system will not be used to announce the 2nd event each day or shoot offs. Watch the 'On Deck' board – do not be late.

White Flyer pitch, Orange Dome targets will be thrown for all Grand Pacific Tournament events (this includes the practice traps).

TARGET SETTING & VOICE CALLS: The target setting committee will set and monitor all targets. Shooters may request elevation changes from the line boss. Other than elevation changes any resetting of targets must be done by an authorized representative of the Target Setting Committee. **NO EXCEPTIONS**.

MAKE-UP TARGETS: Your squad will wait three (3) minutes then proceed without you. If you miss your squad, rejoin after missed trap; for any missed trap then report to the Shoot Coordinator table to be assigned a trap to finish. Make ups are allowed for gun repair, report to Shoot Coordinator. Ten (10) minutes is allowed for gun repair or replacement.

SHOOT OFFS: Ties in Events 1 through 8, 10, and 12 will be carried over to the next event, unless earned yardage will create an unfair advantage. It is the shooter's responsibility to be aware of ties, carry-overs, and shoot-offs. If you think you may be in a tie, check in at the Shoot Coordinator Table. Do not rely on the PA system for notice of shoot offs.

TROPHIES: There must be at least 3 shooters in special categories for trophies. Trophies will be awarded each day – times posted at trophy table. Please pick up your trophies daily or make arrangements if you are unable to pick them up. **No trophies will be mailed.**

2024 PITA HALL OF FAME

TOM GARRIGUS grew up on the Tualatin River in Oregon, near the Hillsboro Trap and Skeet Club. Tom's dad, Don, started Tom shooting trap when he was three years old. Dad would help Tom support the gun and pull the trigger. On one of those days, Tom came home with a black eye, and dad Don was in hot water on the home front.

Tom was a member of the PITA for seventeen years, registering his first targets in 1963. In 1962, as a junior shooter, he shot his first registered ATA targets, winning a Junior trophy at the Oregon State shoot that year. He repeated this win in 1964.

In 1965, Tom joined the Air Force, serving to 1969. He was assigned to the Marksmanship Training Unit and represented the USA at the 1968 Olympics; winning a silver medal in trapshooting. From 1992 to 2002, he served as an assistant shotgun coach of the USA Shooting Team. Later, in 1996, Tom and his wife, Jackie, were referees at the 1996 Olympic Games. Prior to the 1996 Olympics, Tom worked with Gold Medalist Kim Rhode, Silver Medalist Josh Lakotos, and Bronze Medalist, the Pacific Northwest's own, Lance Bade.

A bit of trivia...Tom and fellow Olympic shooter Ray Stafford attended the first ATA Hall of Fame Banquet as members of the Olympic Shooting Team. In 1994, Tom was inducted into the Oregon ATA Hall of Fame. In 2018, Tom was inducted into the nationwide ATA Hall of Fame.

Tom won numerous PITA and ATA trophies in Oregon, Idaho, Montana and at the Grand American. During his shooting career, Tom had eight (8) Grand Pacific wins and fifty-six (56) State/Provincial wins as well as making two (2) appearances on the PITA All Star Team (1976 and 1977).

Tom was very good in sales and teaching others the art of shooting. In sales, he represented Ithaca, Perazzi and Krieghoff shotguns. The good Lord took him in 2006; he is probably still coaching marksmanship.
