This issue of OT2 brings you the results of the Caldwell Spring shoot, the monthly Multiplex, the SRTA championships at Twin Falls, how Idaho shooters did at the Elko Spring Opener shoot, and the Wood River Spring shoot.

#### Caldwell Spring Shoot. April 6, 2024.

Several days of bad weather preceded the shoot causing some very large water pools on the club grounds and holding the attendance down. Many people in the valley area woke up to several inches of wet snow.

22 hardy shooters registered 5,300 targets with Waylon Klundt breaking the only perfect score of the day to top the singles event. He also tied for high in the handicap with 89 and lost a shoot-off to Clay Brown. Waylon edged Clay for the HOA champion's pin by one target. Kyle Perry led doubles scoring by four with his 92.

### **SRTA Championships – Twin Falls Gun Club. April 13-14, 2024.**

Attendance was up, the weather was good, scores were good and 77 shooters fired at 32,700 targets.

Kyle Perry won the singles championship with 199, edging out Clay Brown by one target. He also was the HOA champion with a score of 477. Mike Houser won a shoot-off of four 96's for the doubles championship.

Bobbie Freelove was the winner of the President's handicap on Saturday with a lone 95 and rookie shooter Jaxon Finck won the SRTA handicap on Sunday with his 95. Jaxon also won the Best of the Best Rookie buckle by going 6 straight in the miss-and-out shoot off. Along the way he also earned his first 25 and 50 straight Idaho PITA pins.

Eric Davis also earned his 50 straight pin and Swayd Bailey, Cody Brown, Josiah Graff, and Zach Harpster were awarded their 25 straight Idaho pins.
