Summer is here and the shooting is stepping up the pace. This month OT2 will report the results of the Canyon Classic in Twin Falls, the monthly Multiplex, the doubles and handicap marathons at the Boise Gun Club, and one of the biggest shoots of the year – the PITA Idaho State shoot at the Pocatello Trap Club.

Shuyler lost that shoot-off but he won the HOA champion's pin for the four event total of 379, and he and Chester Carter has 280 scores to lead the doubles shooters for the day.

### **Idaho PITA State Championships. June 28-30. 2024. Pocatello Trap Club.**

Shooters from eight states – Idaho,  
Utah, Nevada, California, Wyoming,  
Washington, Oregon, and Arizona,  
enjoyed mostly nice weather for the  
three days and fired at 53,500 registered  
targets. They also enjoyed buddy shoots,  
two free dinners, and a silent auction.

Sub-Junior shooter Zane Kent won the  
state handicap championship with a  
lone 96, was the High-All-Around champ  
with 386, and was the runner-up in the  
doubles championship.

Kyle Perry won the High-Over-All with a  
762 score and was the state singles  
champion after a tie of 199's with Mike  
Houser. In the state singles there were  
only four perfect scores. Perry and  
Jeremie Summers from Utah had 100's  
in the first half, and Del McDaniel and  
Houser in the second half.  
Tony Shuyler won the state doubles  
crown with an almost perfect 99.

In the Memorial handicaps, junior  
shooter Kelsey Wickham led the scoring  
in the J.O. Cotant Memorial handicap  
with her 95 from 27 yards, and Jeremie  
Summers was high in the Ron Frieze  
Memorial handicap – also a 95 from the  
27 yard line.

The Evan Arnold and Colten Harsch  
Memorial doubles event was topped by  
Perry and Randy Bratton from California  
who both scored 97's.

In the opening event of the shoot – the  
Pete Miller Memorial Singles – Alex  
Bringhurst had the lone 100 straight.
