July was a hot month with hot temperatures, fires, and a lot of smoke for places in Idaho.

Idaho shooters had their best month ever in the Multiplex, shot the Buckmaster and Young Memorial shoots at Boise, and then closed the month out by traveling to Bend for more smoke and the Grand Pacific. Here are the results.

July Multiplex.

36 clubs 299 shooters. 40,200 targets Handicap punches – 50 (1) 1 yard. 49 (1) 1 yard. 48 (8) half yard.
