This issue of OT2 will bring you the results of the Multiplex shoots for October and November as well as information on an important change in the selection process for the Idaho PITA All-Star teams beginning with the 2025 target shooting year.

## Change in Selection Process for the Idaho PITA All-Star Teams.

Beginning with target year 2025 all teams will be selected based on composite target average along with the following requirements:

Open and Men's Team – 1,000 singles, 1,000 handicap and 700 doubles.

Ladies' Team – 500 singles, 500 handicap and 200 doubles.

Vet categories and Juniors – 500 singles, 500 handicap and 200 doubles.

Along with the minimum target requirements, all must shoot four clubs (in state or out) and the ID PITA state shoot the HAA Events.

#### October Multiplex Results.
