BILL GLEED TAKES HONORS PACIFIC INTERNATIONAL SHOOT

Many Prominent Shooters Present for Trapshoot

Bill Glead shot his way to high honors and money in the final at Montana's first Pacific International Trapshooting association meet at Butte Sunday. Glead broke 94 birds out of 100 to win first place in the Great Eastern Handicap with Jack Barrett of Dillon crowding him hard with 93 and Bill Bradley of Butte breaking 92 for third place.

Floyd Lewis of Pocatello won first place in the Eastern Singles with a break of 197 out of 200. Ted Renfro, O. A. Schulz, Sheridan, and Art Meehan of Spokane were deadlocked for second place with 195 birds each. Meehan won the shootoff to take prize money.

The P.I.T.A was formed in 1930 with Montana joining in 1931, holding their first state shoot that same year. Records remain elusive for the early 1930s. In 1938 Montana state shoot was held in Butte, bringing shooters from all over including Oregon, Washington, and California (see news clips). In 1939 PITA yearbook E.W. "Ted" Renfro held the top spot in High Guns for Singles and Handicap in the state of Montana. In 1940 Helena held the Grand Pacific. No records for Montana for 1941-45 and then rejoined in 1946-47. Many years passed and then again in 2024 a few dedicated shooters helped MT rejoin in order to hold the Fall Classic telephonic shoot in Libby.

HIGH WESTERN TRAP GUNNERS TO COME HERE

Some of the nation's outstanding trapshooters, including several who have won fame in national competition, will show their wares here July 7-9 during the Montana Sportsmen's association 1939 state trapshooting championships. It was announced yesterday by officials of the Butte Trap and Skeet club, which is sponsoring the annual tournament.

Out-of-state gunners will not be eligible for state championship trophies, but they will be eligible to compete for many of the cash prizes in the meet. Charles O'Connell, president of the trap and skeet club, said he had received many inquiries from out-of-state shooters concerning this year's program and many of the inquiries come from stars who were high gunners in the eastern division of the Pacific International Trapshooting association shoot held here in August of last year.

Among the stars who have written in for information about the state tournament are Joe Cotant, Pocatello, Idaho, gunner who is state champion in Idaho; Floyd Lewis, another Pocatello shooter who ranked high in the P. I. T. A. shoot here last year; Guy Chelaman of Spokane, another last year's competitor; Art Meehan, Dr. Richard Fitzhery and Charles Fouts, all of Spokane.

Others who may show their ability in the tournament next month include H. B. Carlyle, several-time Utah state champion; his son, Harvey Jr., who is a high-ranking junior trapshooter; D. C. Fish of Portland, Ore., and others.

Against such stellar opposition Montana will pit such outstanding competitors as Ted Renfro, Delli, several-time national champion and defending titleholder in the state handicap and doubles division; Joe Latimer, Butte, state singles champion; Robert Poore of Butte, prominent for many years in nationwide junior competition; George Mickey, Havre; Val Lechner, Billings; Virgil Rothrock, Billings; G. H. Kreis, Glendive; Otto Schultz, Sheridan, and Herman Peterson, Billings, others who have represented the Treasure state in national circles.

REGISTRATION AND CROSS-REGISTRATION

All targets in the program will be registered with the PITA. Targets may be cross-registered with the ATA, subject to all the fees, rules, and requirements. The shooter must be a current member of the ATA and pay all appropriate ATA daily fees and target fees. Earned yardage will be awarded according to the rules of PITA and will apply directly to all cross-registered targets. ATA & PITA will be punched.

HANDICAPPING & CLASSIFICATION

PITA rules will govern this shoot. It is the shooter's responsibility to show both PITA and ATA average cards to determine handicap yardage assignment.

This shoot is considered to be a **MAJOR** tournament, therefore penalty yardage and classification will be assessed per the 2024-2025 PITA rule book on pages 31-37.

In addition, the requirement of stated number of PITA registered targets may be satisfied by the substitution of like number of registered ATA targets per the PITA rule book on page 31.

Errors at the classification table does not relieve the shooters of this responsibility.
